There is a great abundance of OER relating to leadership with a particular focus on leadership in business. Generally there is not a specific gap, but there may be more materials instructors desire or could be created to highlight leadership in other fields. Since there are many OER



textbooks and online courses covering the topic of leadership, perhaps an area of growth would be developing OER assignments, test banks, and student exercises.

- Comments: This OER highlights that organizations need culturally intelligent managers and leaders, and that cultural intelligence is both a strategy and a tool. The author is an immigrant refugee and brings learned experience in addition to professional experience to the text. The textbook outlines the importance of cultural intelligence, steps that need to be considered, and then how to practice becoming a culturally intelligent leader. The text contains 8 chapters, which could also be used individually if that better fits the course.

strongest chapter for this course context, but chapter 5 also explores values based leadership and chapter 8 is focused on organizational structure and change.

The primary lens that this OER approaches leadership is within the education environment. It is likely that the book in its entirety may not be suitable as the course's text, but specific chapters are likely to be useful as course readings.

The text presents the theory, concepts, and applications with particular emphasis on the impact that individuals and groups can have on organizational performance and culture. The text engages students with entrepreneurial thinking, managing change, using tools/technology, and responsible management. Additionally, OpenStax offers additional resources for instructors, such as course cartridges and test banks. If the entire OER textbook is not the right fit, some chapters and the test banks may be excellent supplements for the course.

introduction, leadership theory, change management and decision making, leading without formal authority, and managing groups and teams. This may potentially be a resource that is assigned in the course. Additionally, the supplemental material, such as the study guide, may also be useful. All content, with the exception of the final exam is under a CC BY license, and could legally be exported, remixed, and reused to fit the course context.
