Methodology:

Purpose

The 2005 Kent County Literacy Survey is an assessment of the English language literacy skills of Kent County residents age 18 and older. The definition of literacy used in this survey is: *the ability to use printed and written information to function in society, to achieve one's goals, and to develop one's knowledge and potential.*

Survey Content

The survey questions were adapted from the National Assessment of Adult Literacy (NAAL) to allow for national comparison. Questions focus on a board range of tasks that adults perform in order to function at work, at home, and in the community. More specifically, the survey results provide information about background factors associated with literacy, the skill levels of the adults, and the application of literacy skills in daily life.

Methodology Statement


The 2005 Kent County Literacy Survey was conducted during the first three weeks of August. It involved 400 random-digit-dial telephone interviews, resulting in an overall 4.9% margin of error. The survey was available in English and Spanish. When analyzing data for the total sample, responses are weighted to reflect the actual educational attainment levels of Kent County residents.




Question 4: How often do you read....in English? Would you say...
















Question 15: How difficult is it for you to read notes sent home from school? Would you say you have...




Question 17: In the last month, how often did you...




