About the Community Research Institute

The annual Greater Grand Rapids Community Survey is a powerful tool for understanding the needs of Kent County residents. The driving philosophy behind the questionnaire is that citizen well-being can be measured by the extent to which their basic needs are met. The core questions of the survey relate to areas such as education, employment, housing and health. All core questions are asked on an annual basis. This design yields measurements for many different time periods and records patterns of change for longitudinal analysis.

It is our hope that when the survey results are provided to the community, local human service providers will use the results to make informed decisions that will strengthen community. Specific ways survey results can be used by local agencies include:

- Monitor trends and identify emerging community problems
- Characterize disparities across sub populations/communities
- Establish priorities and plan programs
- Evaluate progress in meeting community goals
- Disseminate information to engage community and policymakers
- Support grant applications and other funding opportunities

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Methodology:

The 2006 Greater Grand Rapids Community Survey is a collaborative effort between the Community Research Institute at the Johnson Center for Philanthropy, The Delta Strategy, Heart of West Michigan United Way, and the Doug and Maria DeVos Foundation. The purpose of this year's survey is to assess citizen opinions, perceptions and behaviors relating to civic engagement, basic needs, health, education, and religion in the Greater Grand Rapids Area (Kent County).

Sampling/Population:

Respondents were telephoned in May and June 2006 by Precision Research (Phoenix, AZ) and asked to participate in the survey. Time to complete the survey was estimated at 16 minutes. No identifying information was recorded other than demographic information.

This project includes surveys of 1351 adults, aged 18 and up. The calls were staggered to provide week day and week end sample representation. In addition, calls were made during different times of the day so that a proper representation was collected for when respondents are at home. Each sample record was dialed 6 times before moving on to the next sample record. If a qualified respondent was reached on the 5th attempt but did not complete the survey, a 6th and 7th attempt were made. If a qualified respondent was reached on the 6th attempt but did not complete, a 7th and 8th attempt were made.

In order to increase our ability to generalize survey results to Kent County's population, this project involved oversampling of minorities. This approach necessitated the use of multiple sampling strategies. Calls were made using standard RDD procedures until the projects Caucasian quota was met (500 households). During these calls, interviews were be randomized within each household using the birthday rule.

To meet the project's African American quota, an RDD sample was drawn for census tracts with more than a 20% African American population. To meet the Hispanic quota, census tracts with more than a 20% Hispanic population were RDD sampled. In addition, a list was purchased from a list house based on Hispanic surnames. Respondents had the option of taking the survey in Spanish.

Data in this report has been weighted by race so that results can be more accurately generalized to Kent County's population.

Margin of Error: The margin of error for the overall sample is +/- 2.7%. Subgroup responses will have a larger margin of error, depending on the size of the group.

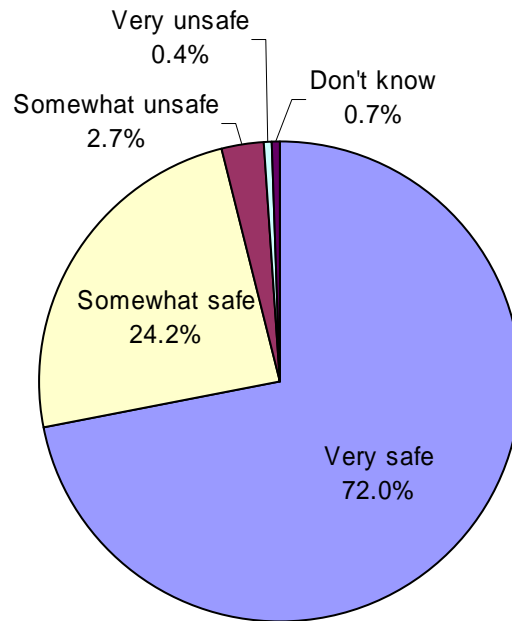

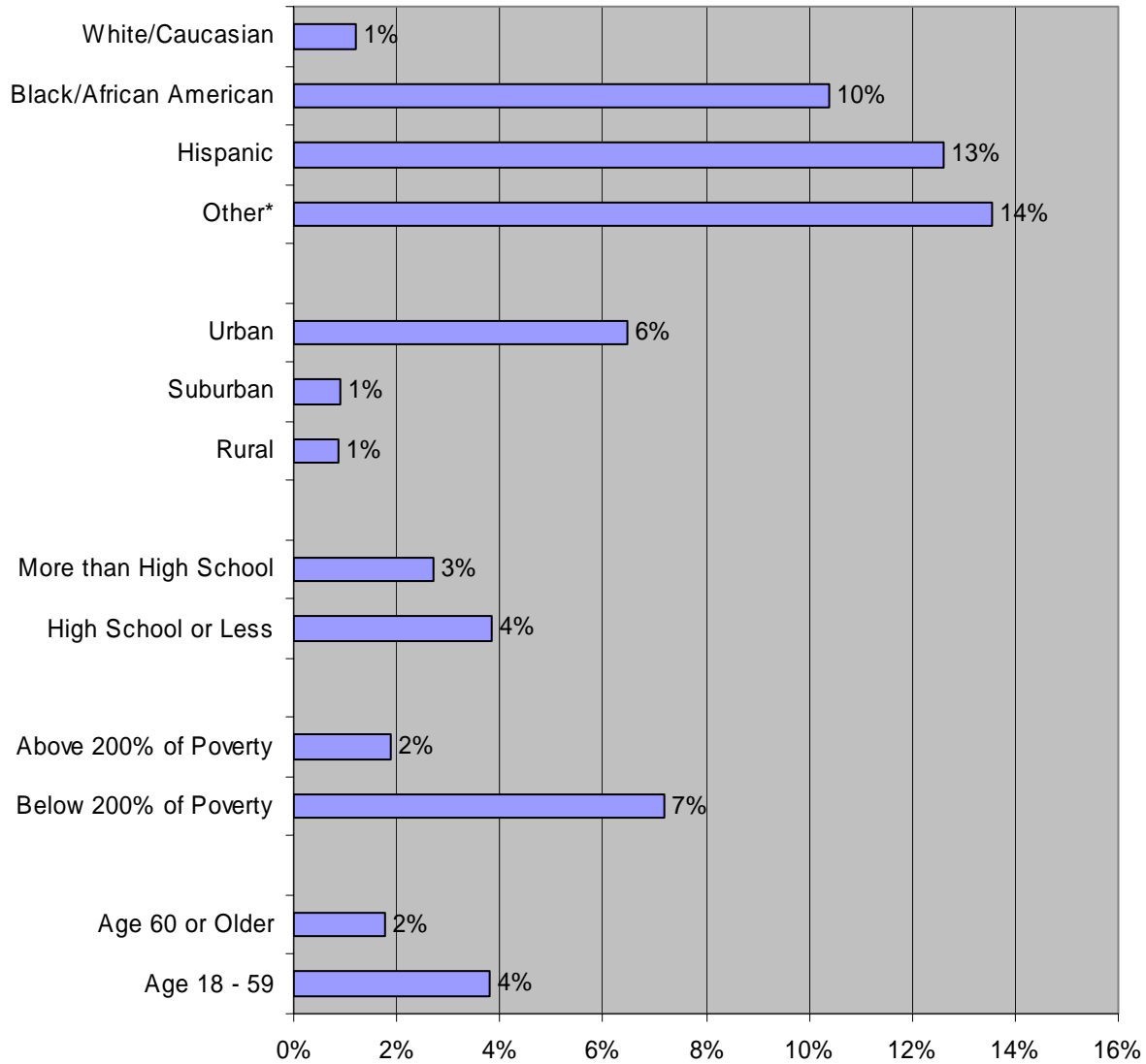
**Question: How safe do you feel in your neighborhood?

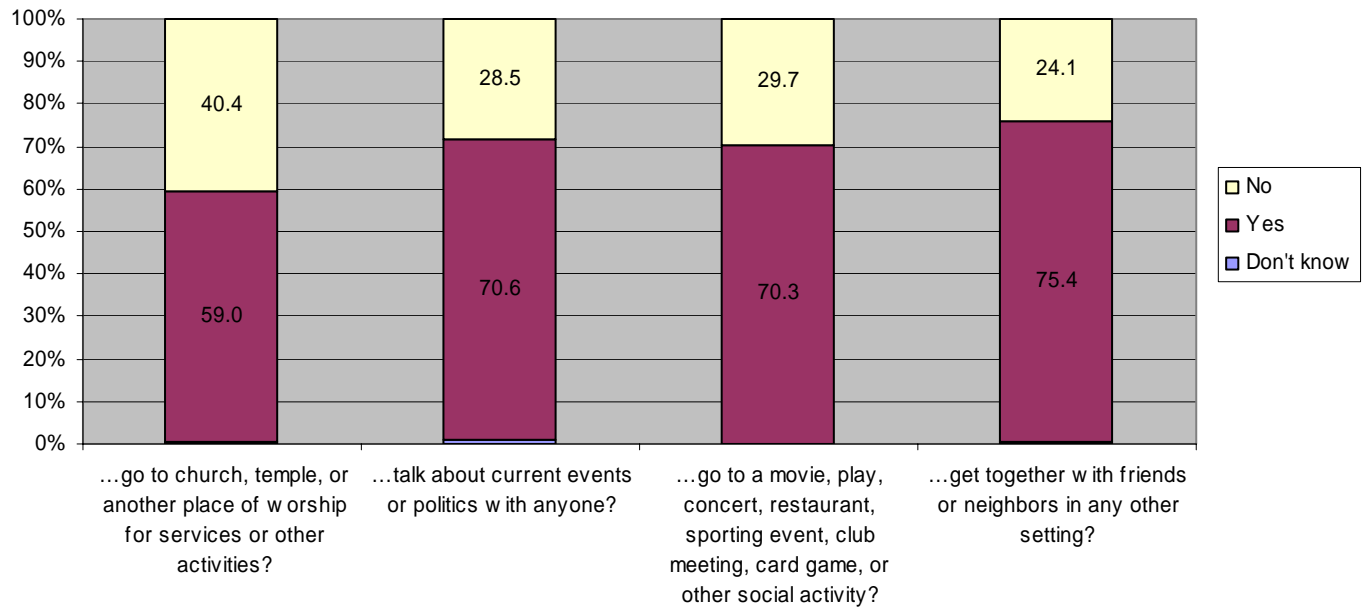

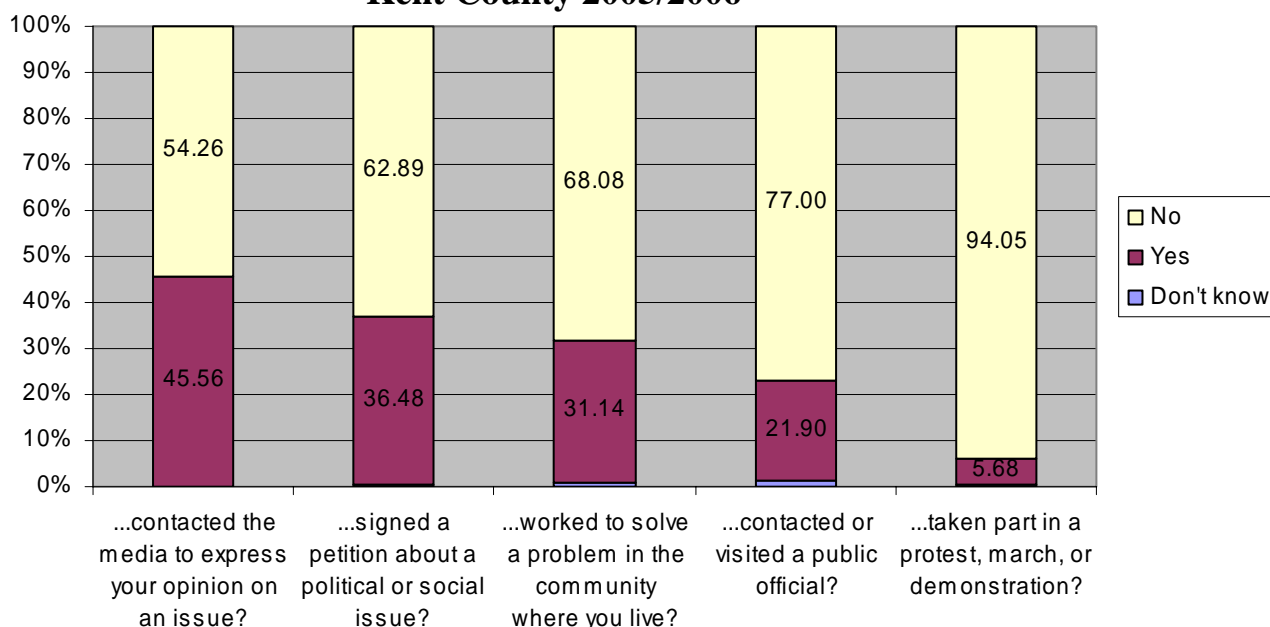

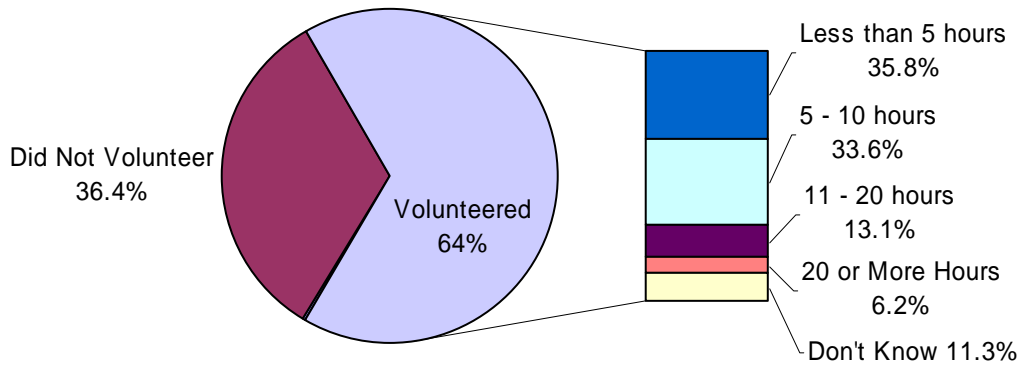

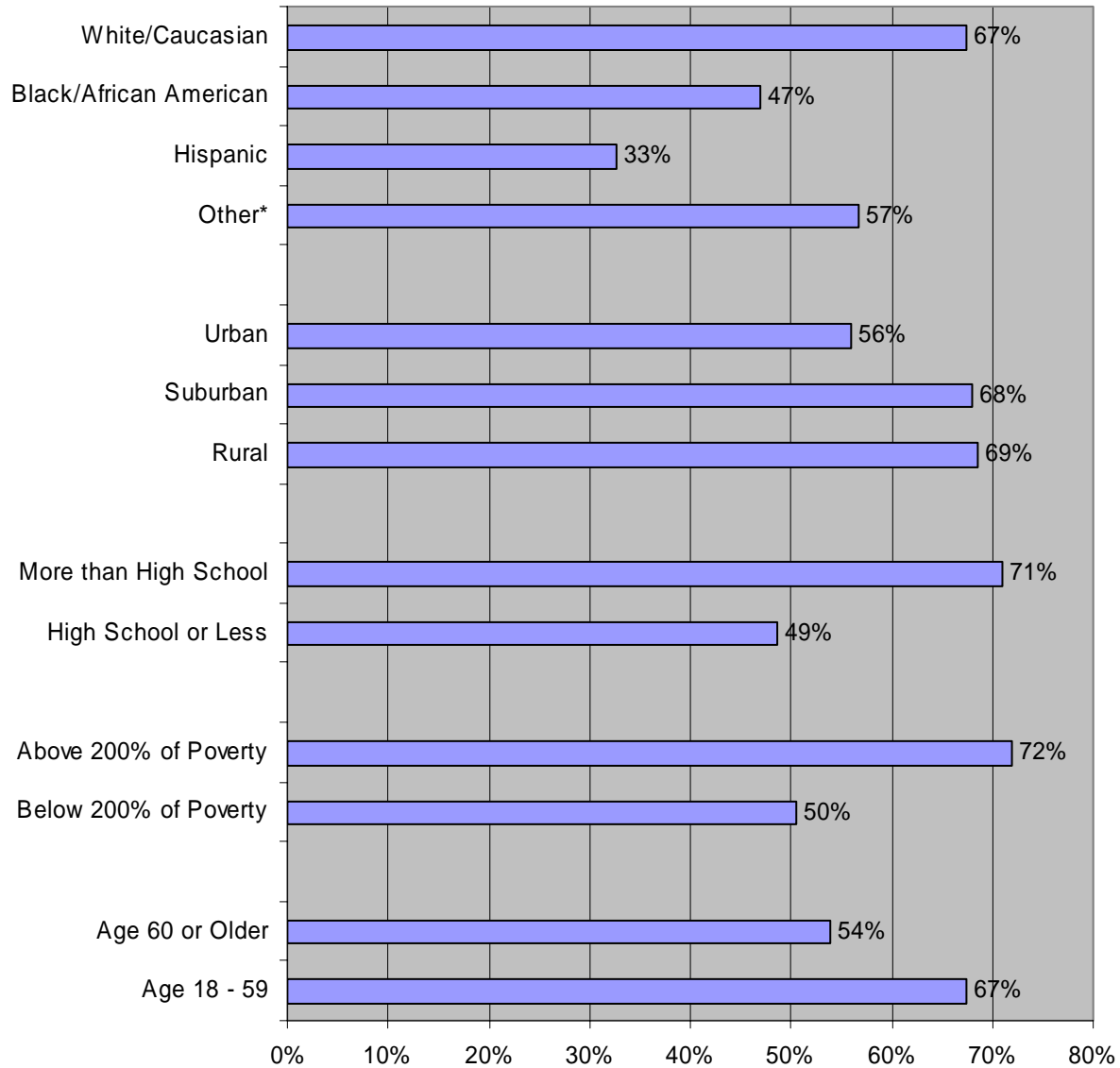
**Question: In the past 12 months have you done any volunteer work

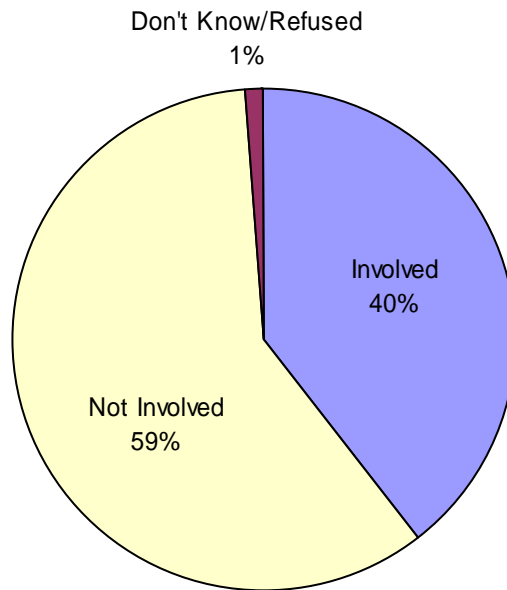

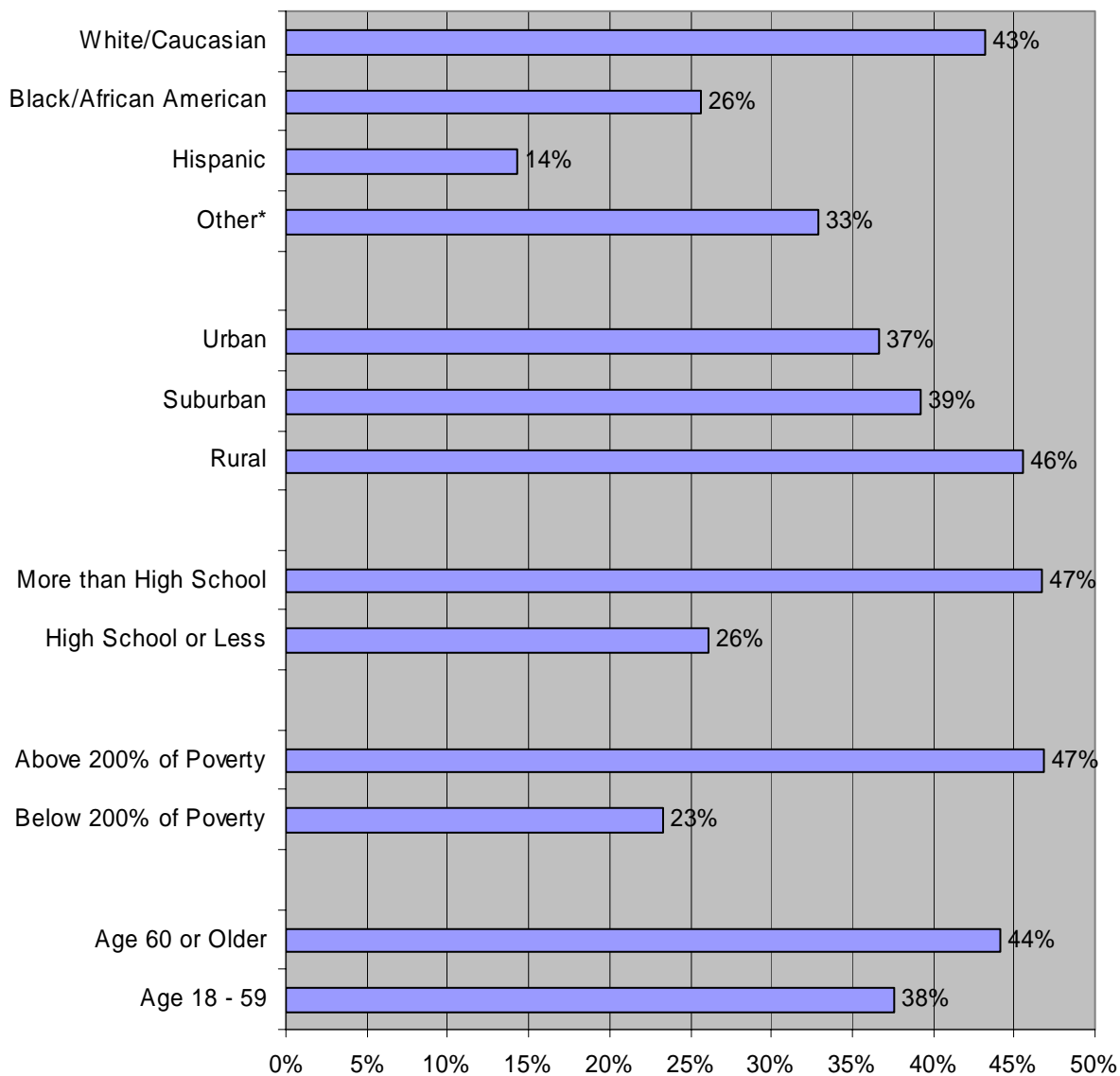
**Do you belong to or are you involved in any local groups, clubs or associations?

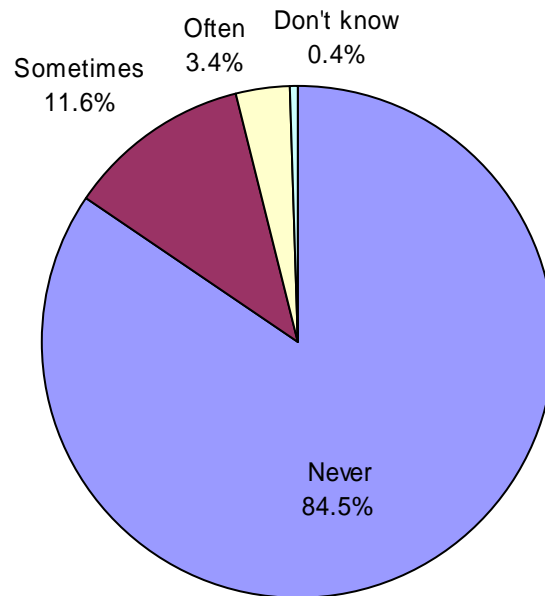

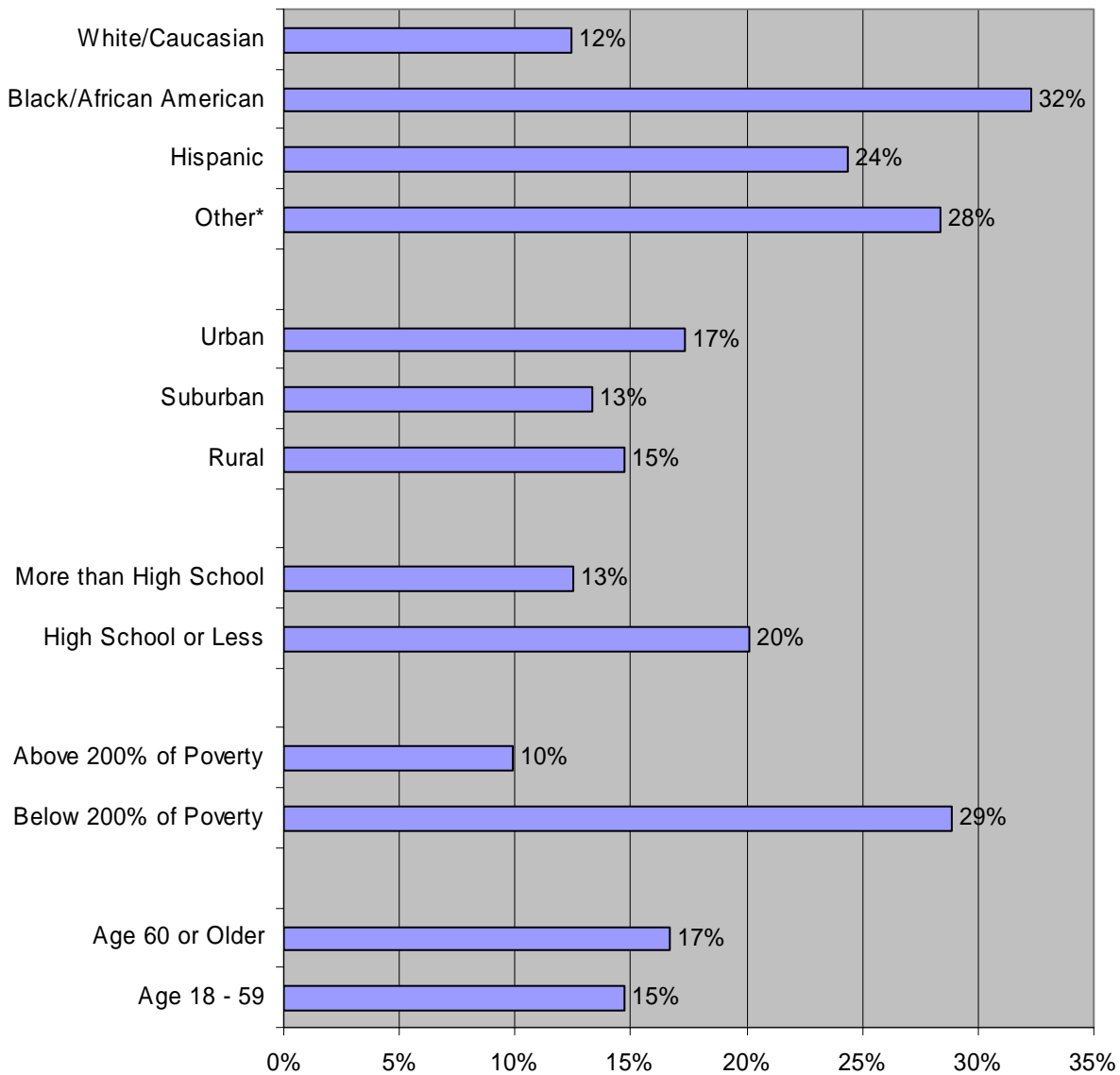
**How often is lack of transportation a problem for you in getting to work or other places you need to go?

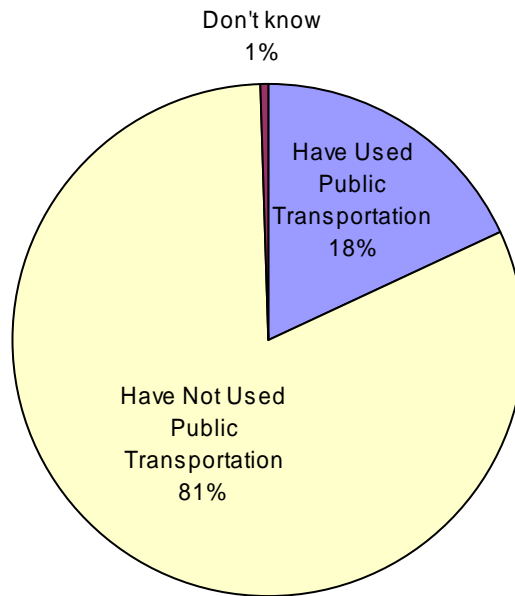

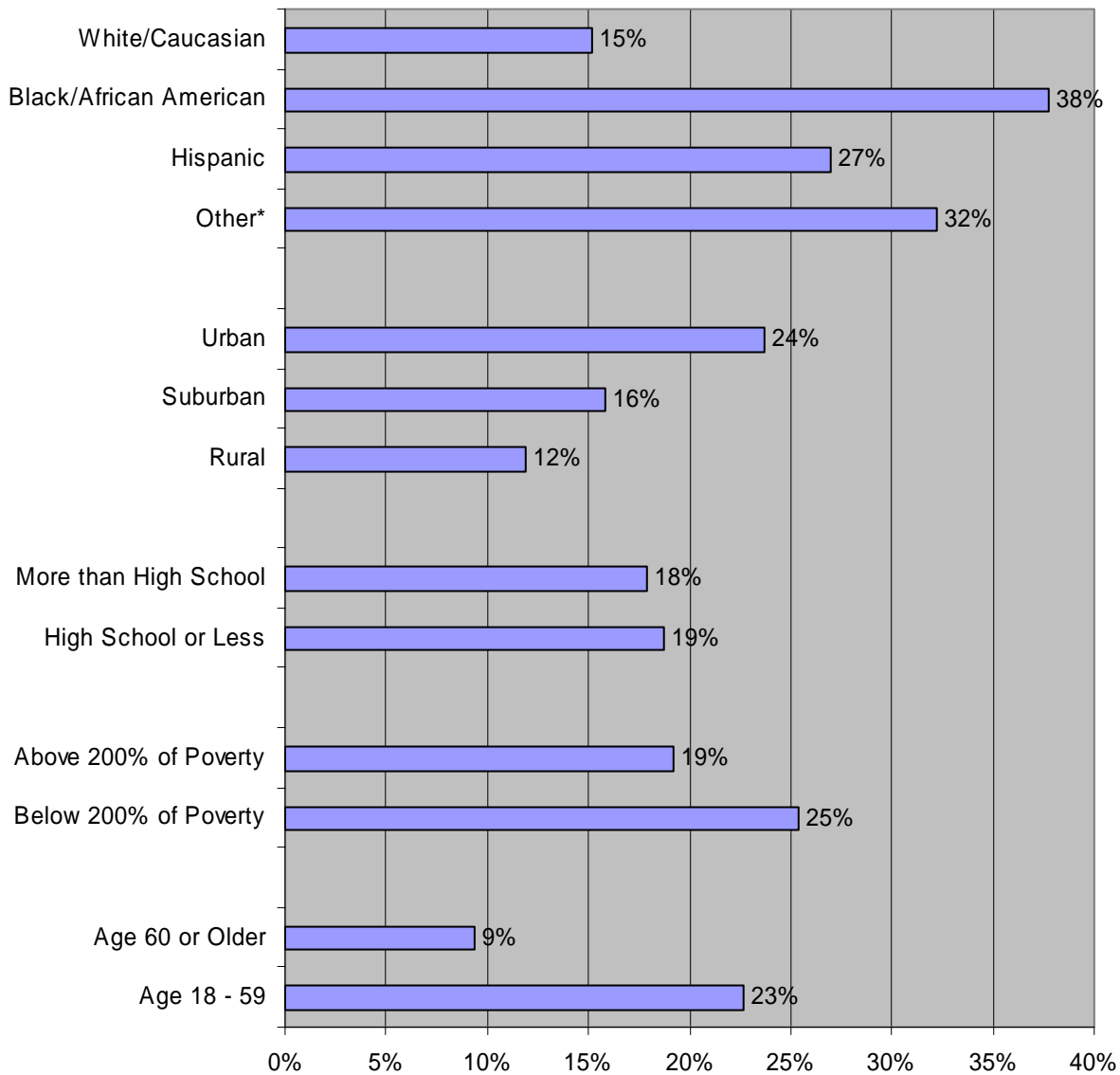
Have you used public transportation in the past year? **Kent County 2006**

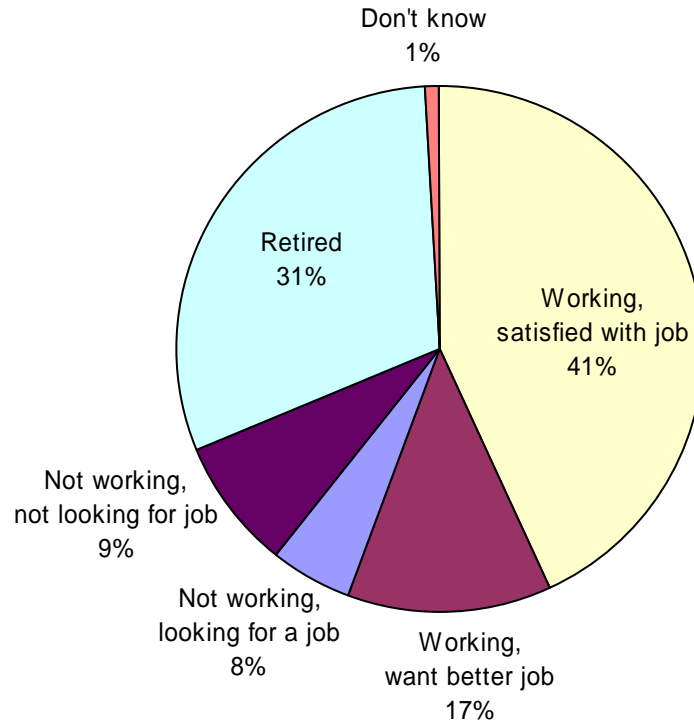

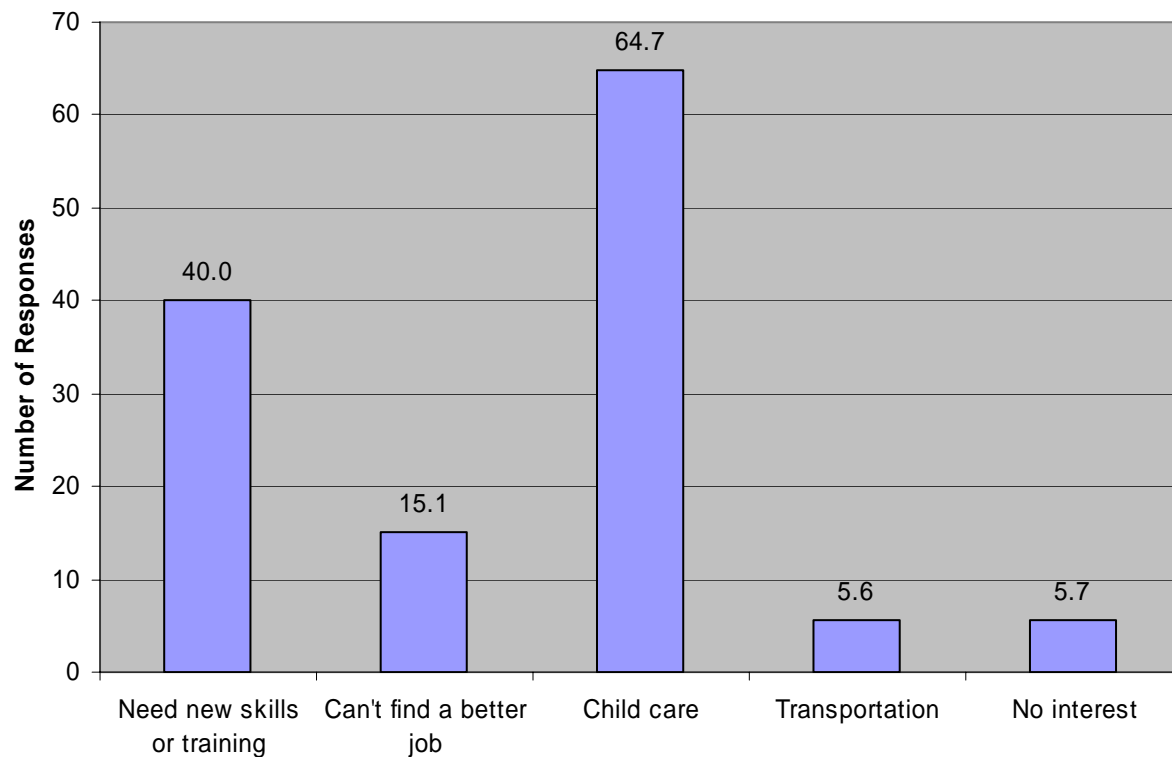

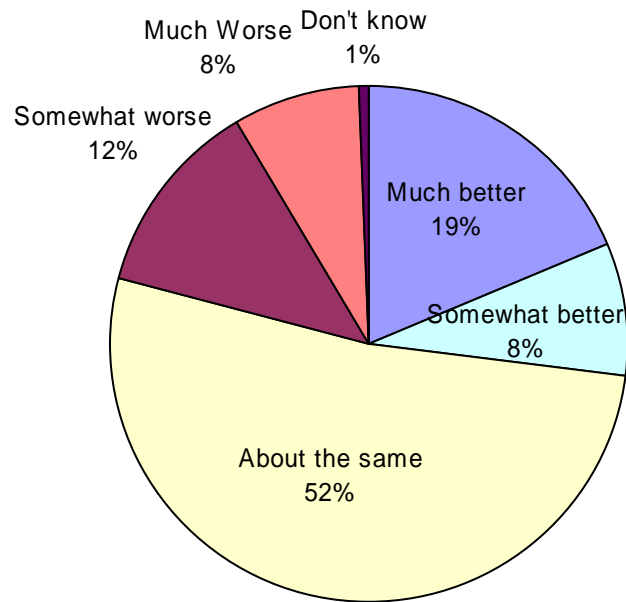
**How would you describe your current employment status?

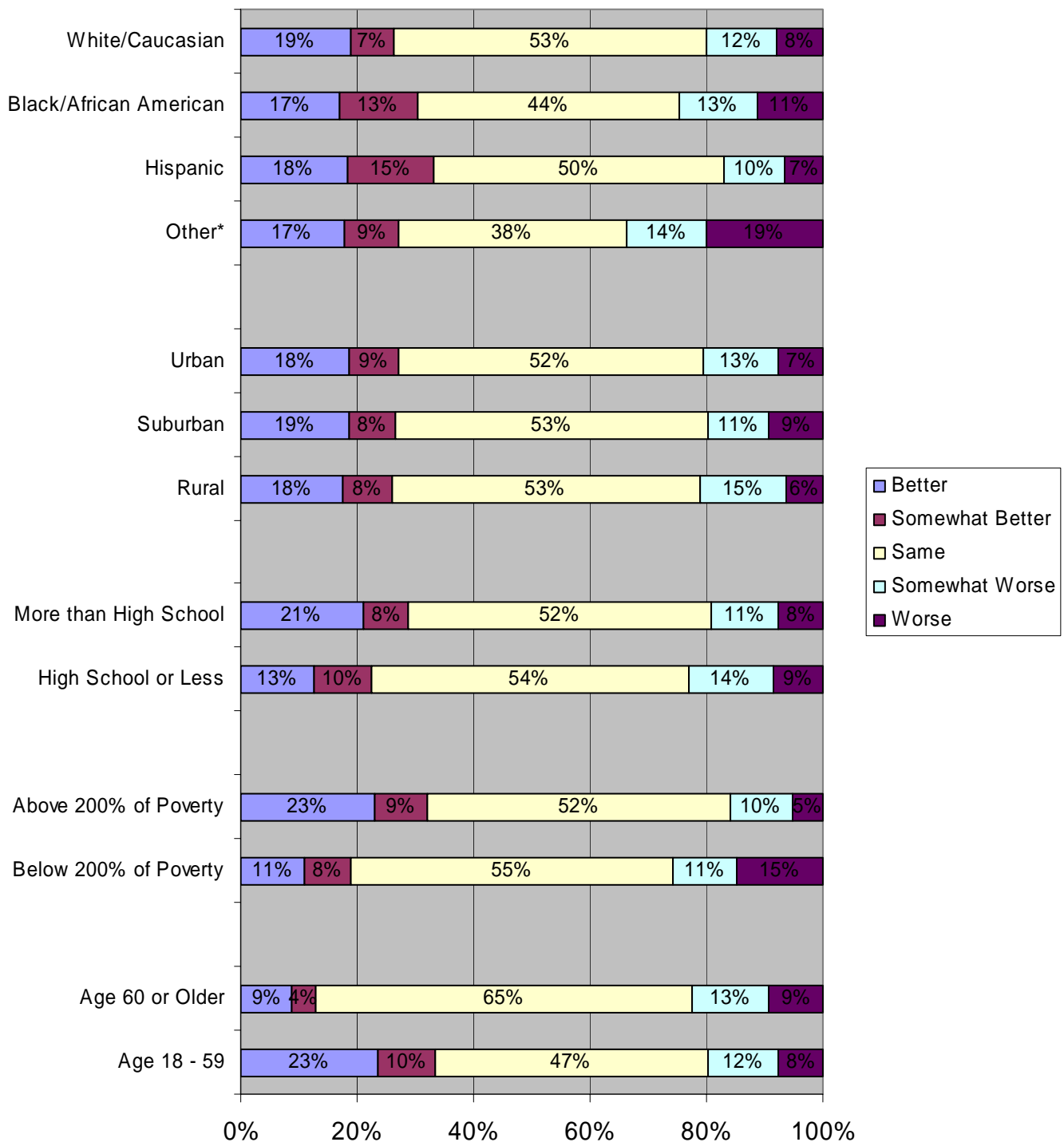
How well are you and your family doing financially today compared to a year ago?

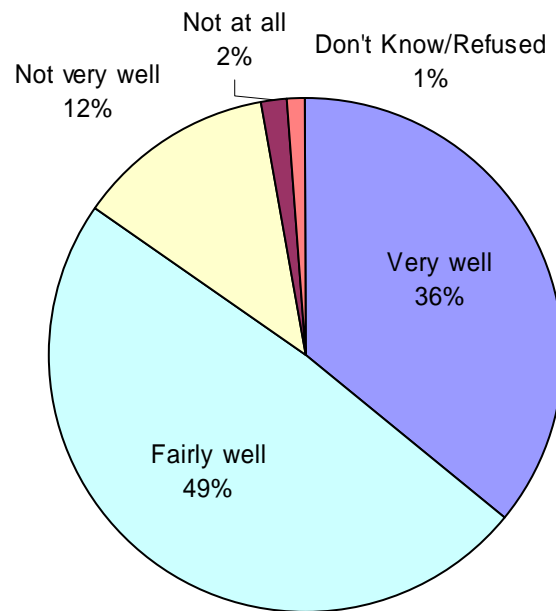

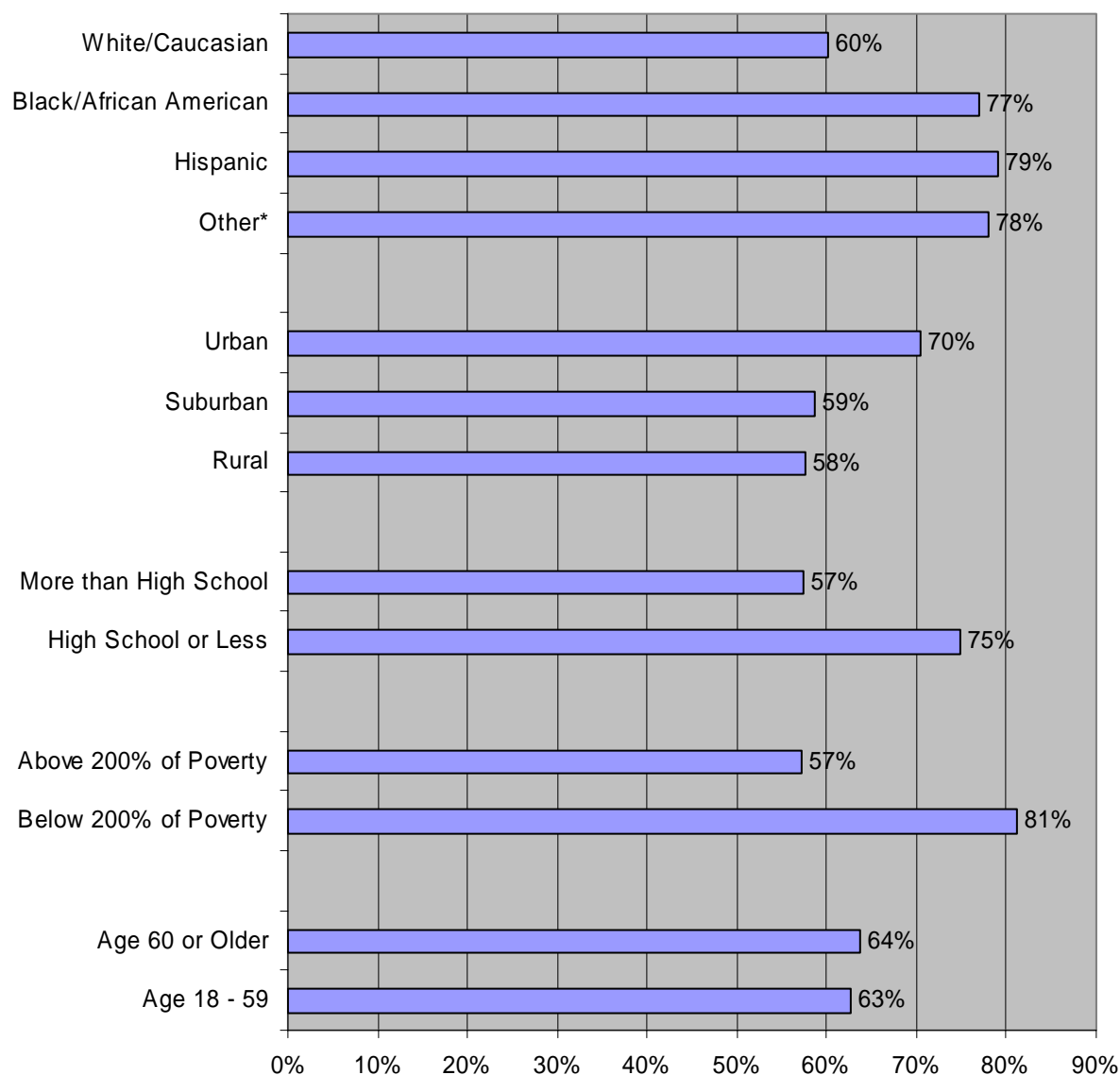
**Question: How well does the amount of money you have take care of your necessities?

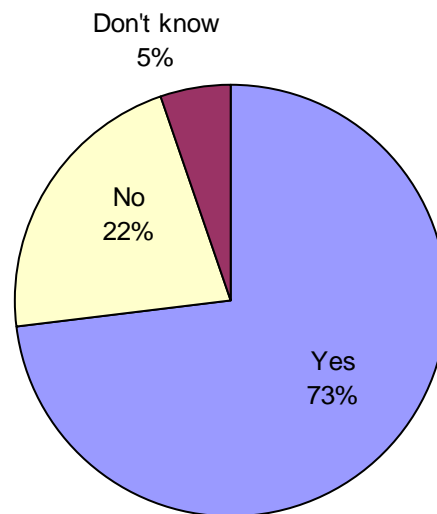

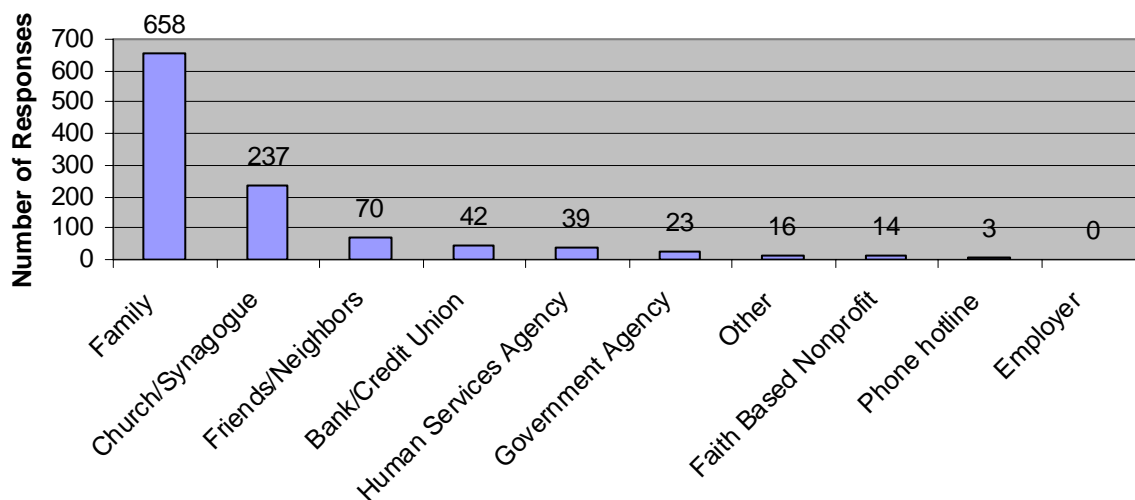

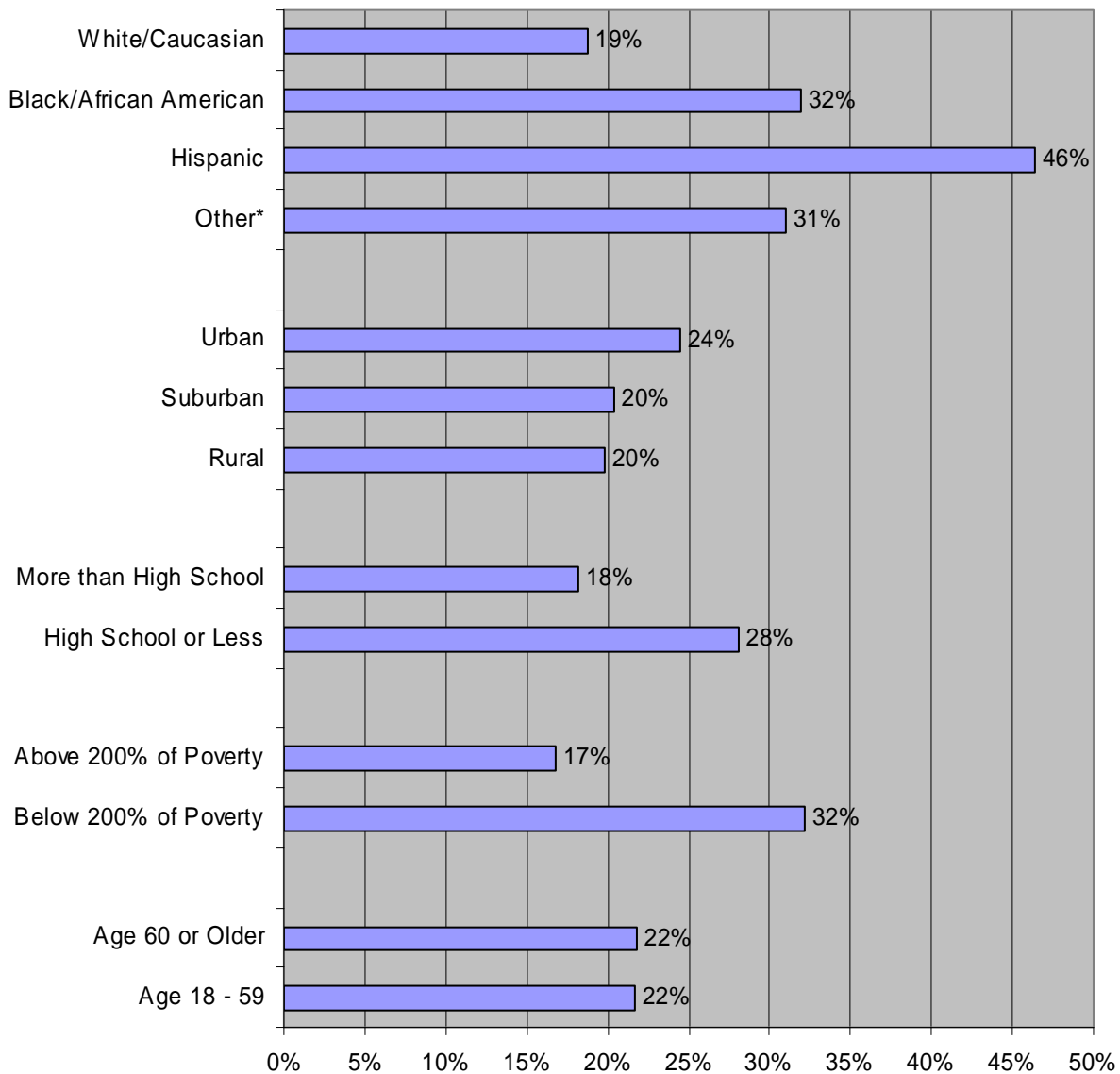
IF YES...Who or where would you turn?



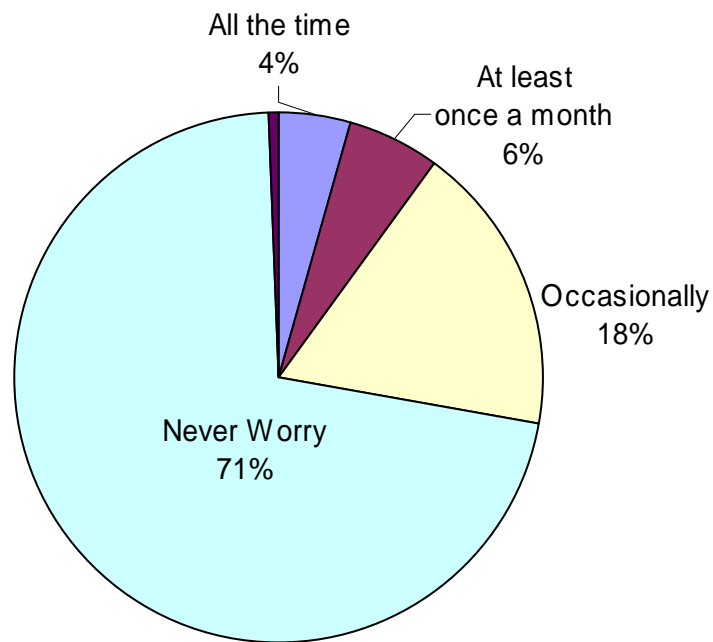

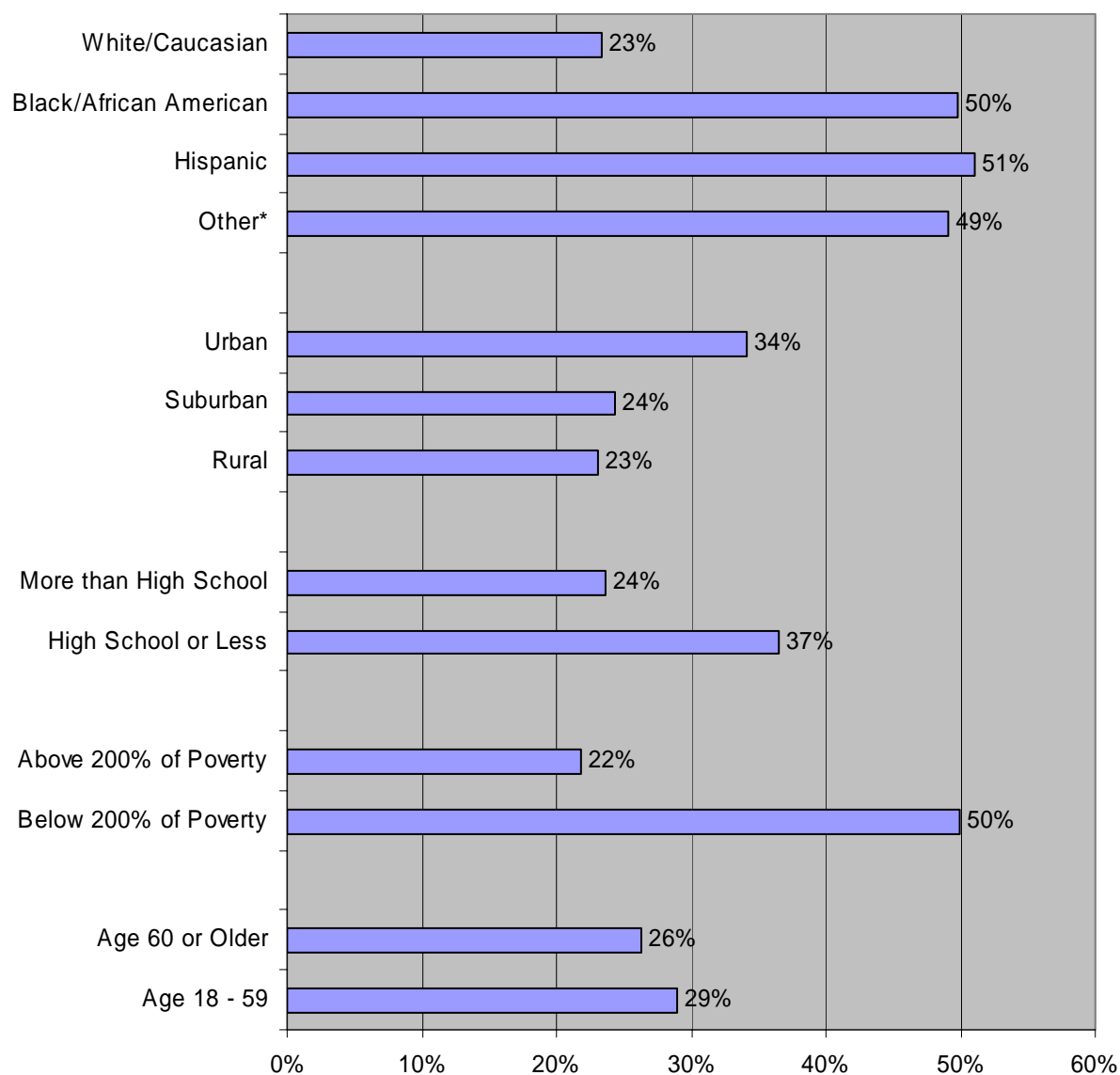
**How often do you worry about running out of money for food or clothing?

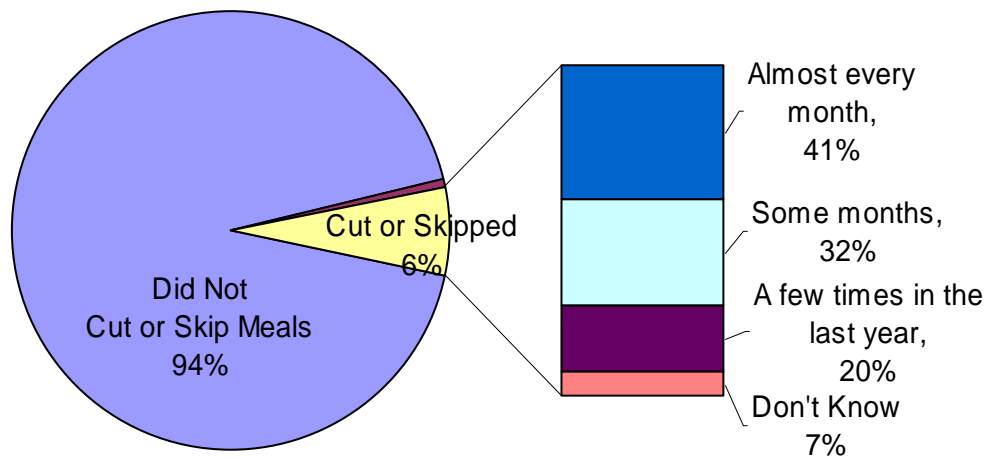

IF YES...How often would you say this happened?

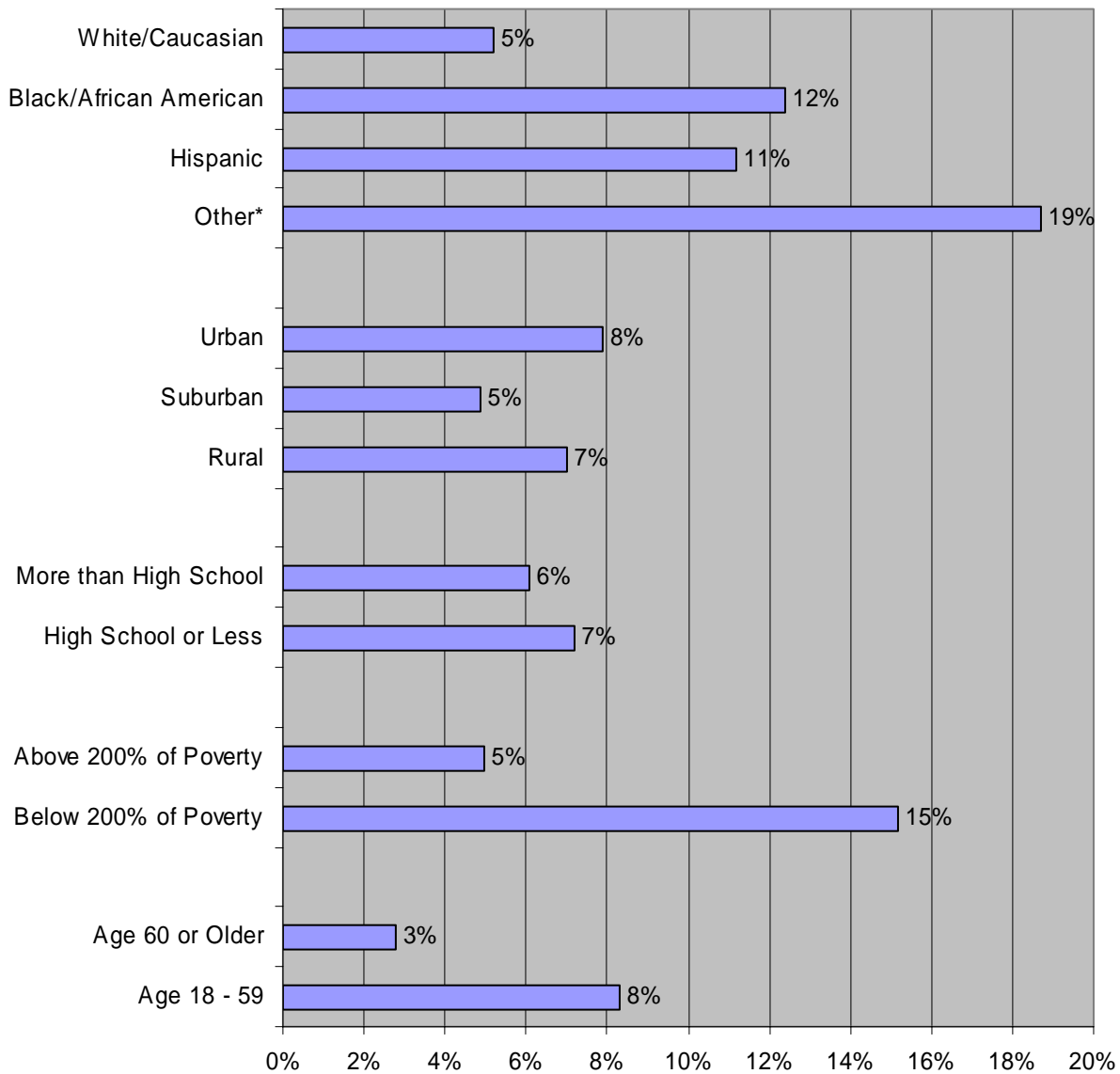

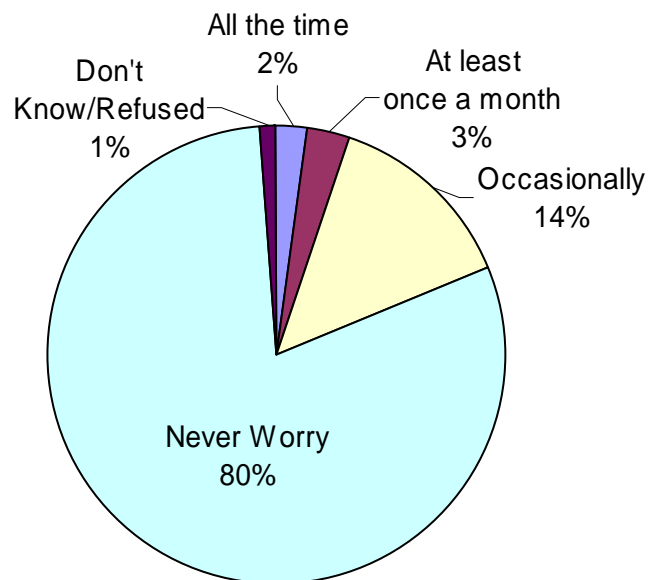

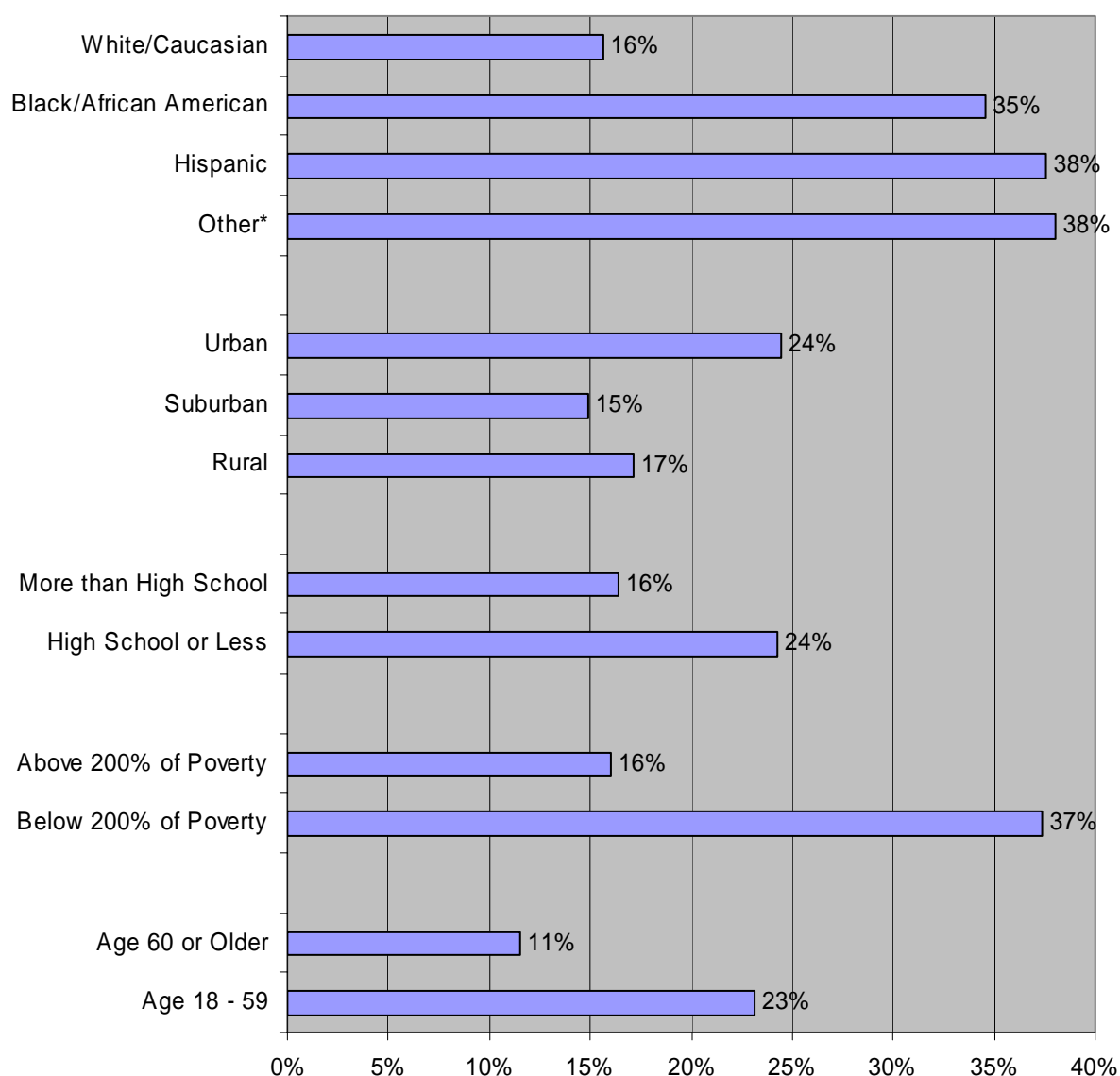
**How often do you worry about running out of money for shelter

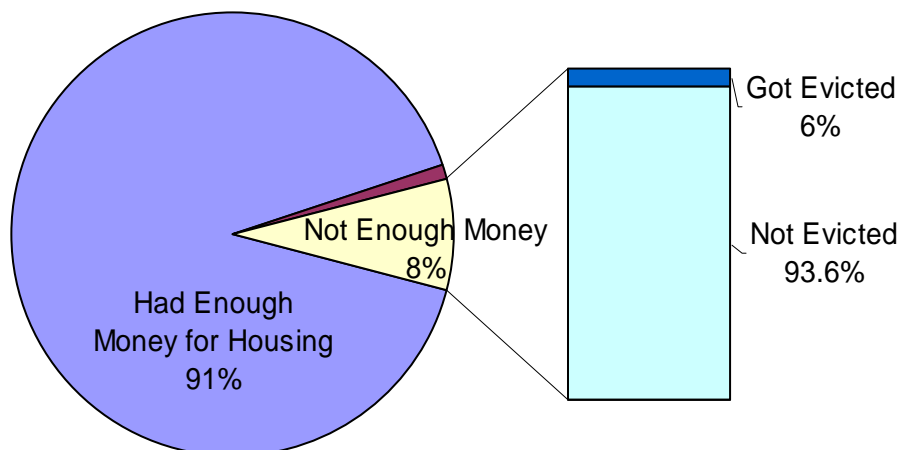

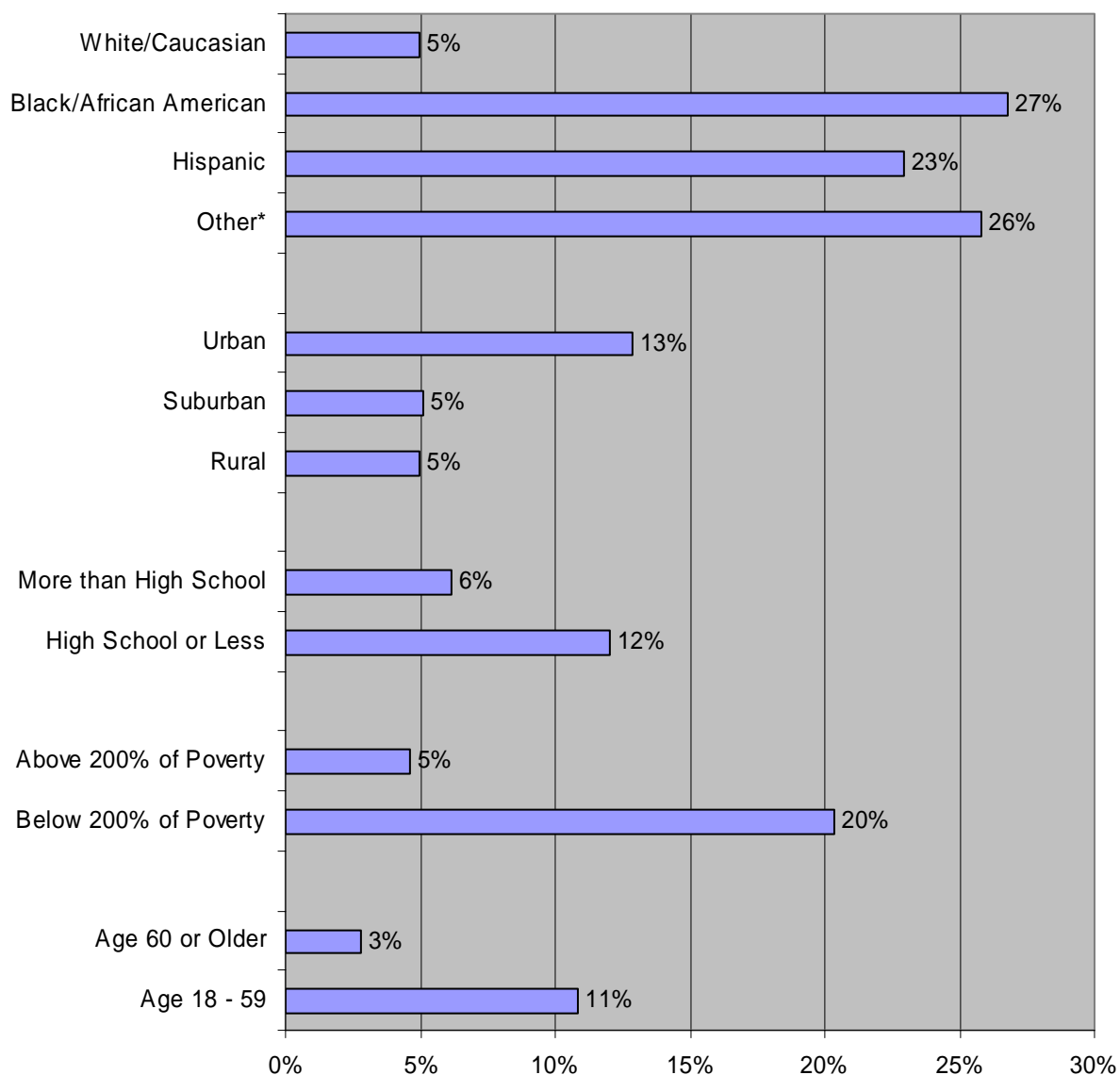
**Question: Were there any times in the past 12 months when you or other adults in your household did not have enough money to pay your rent, mortgage, or real estate taxes?

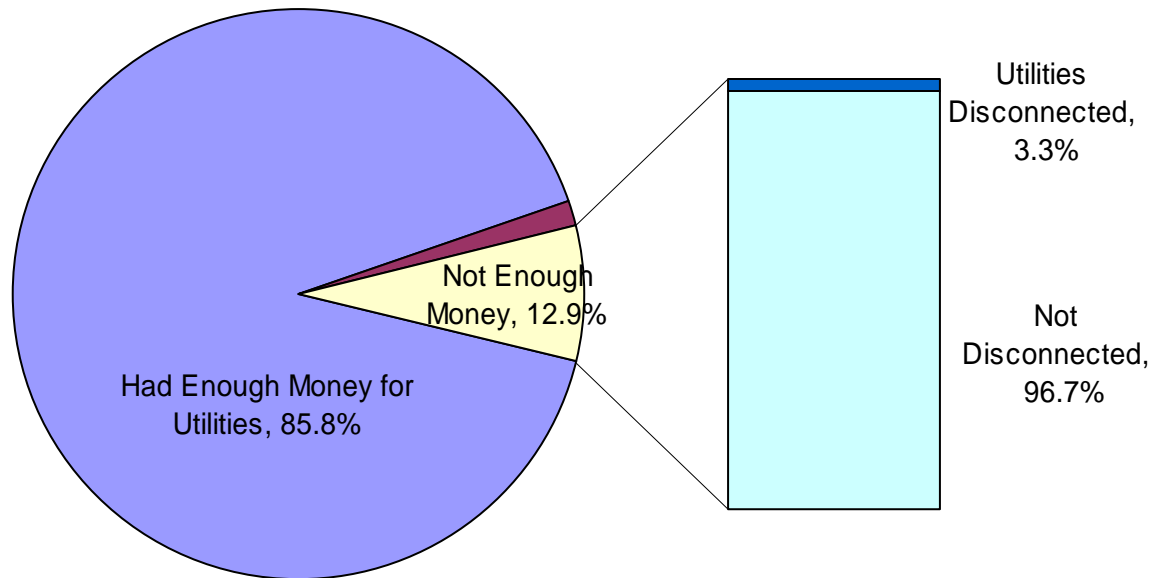

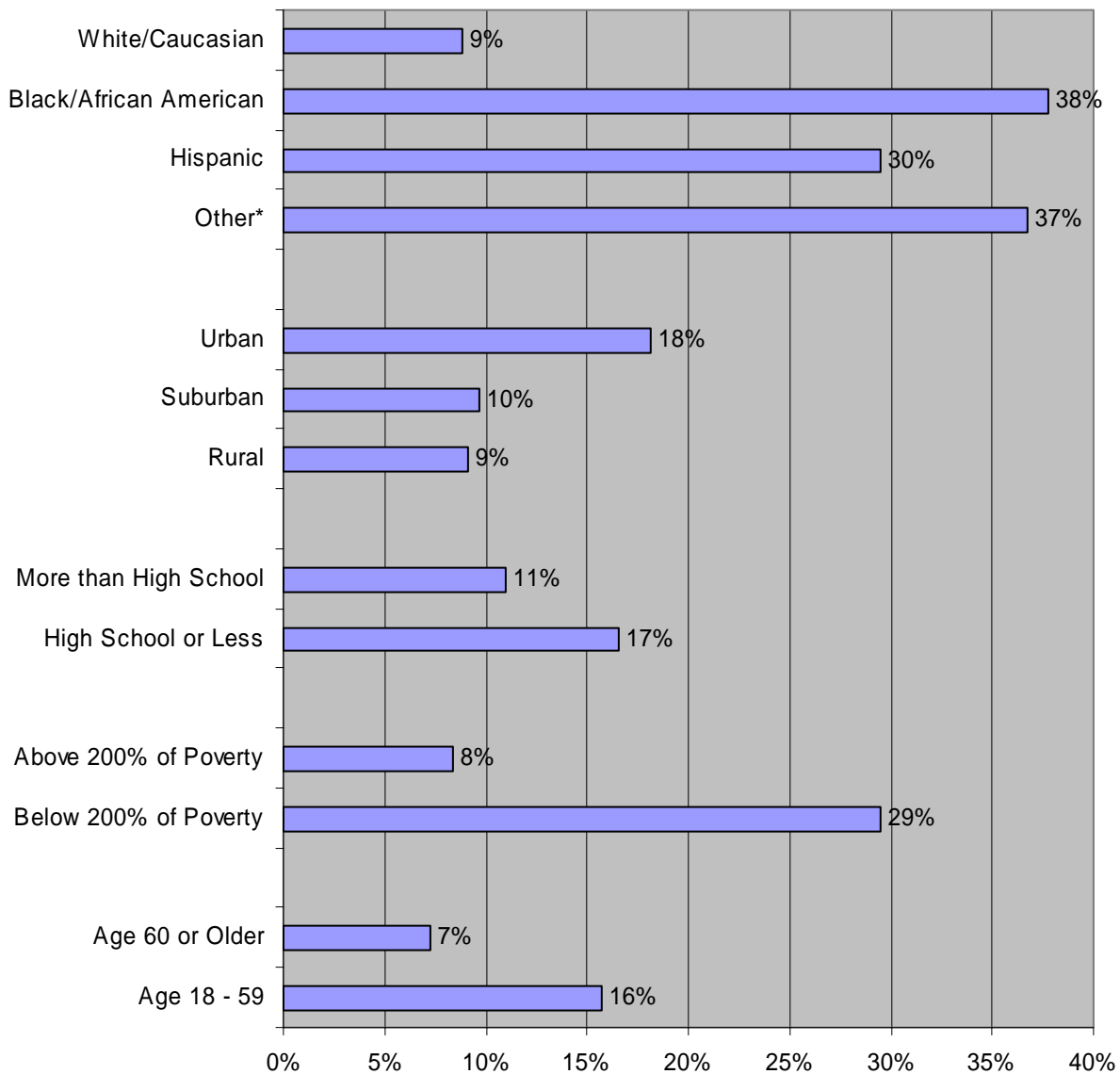

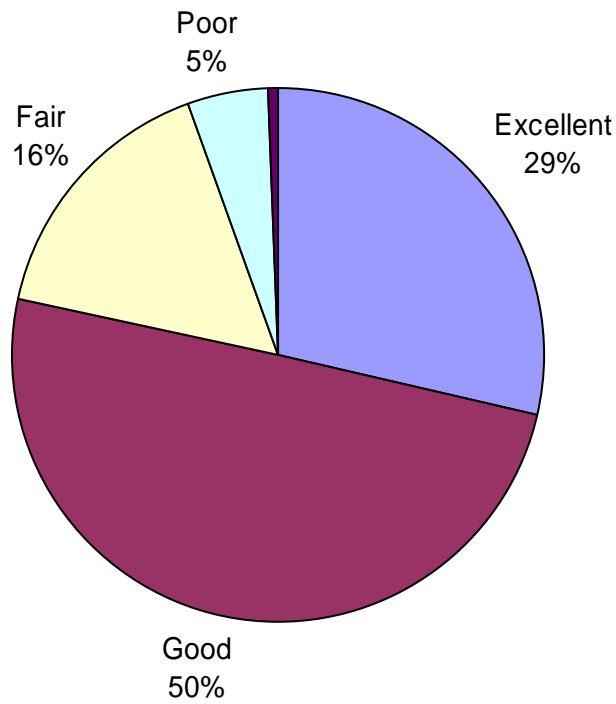

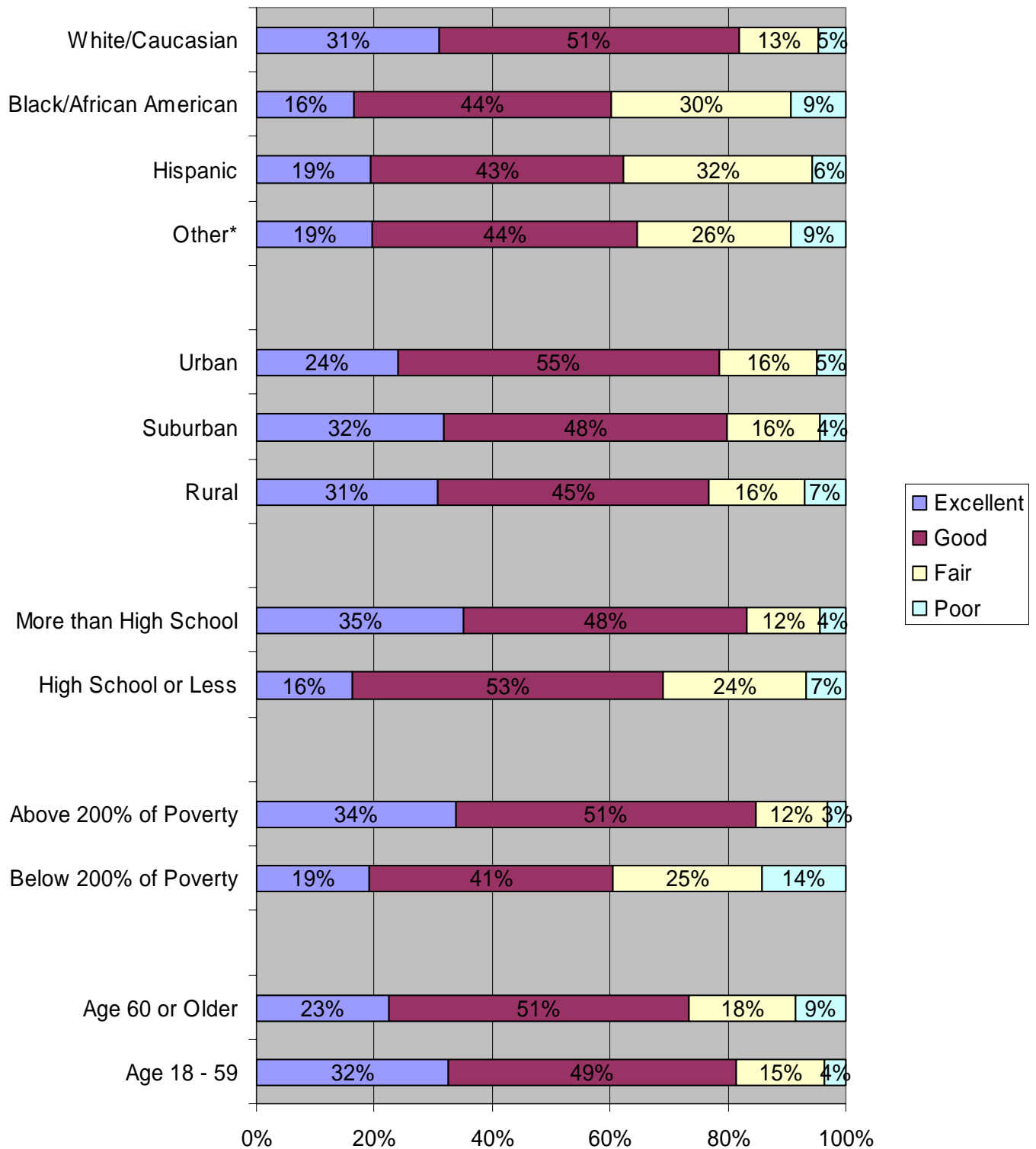
**How would you rate your health?

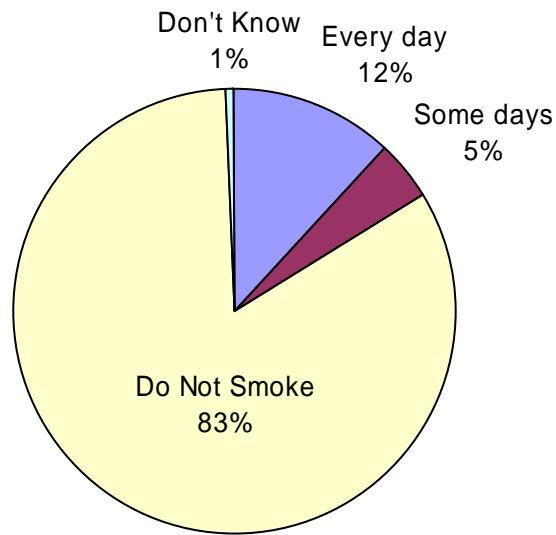

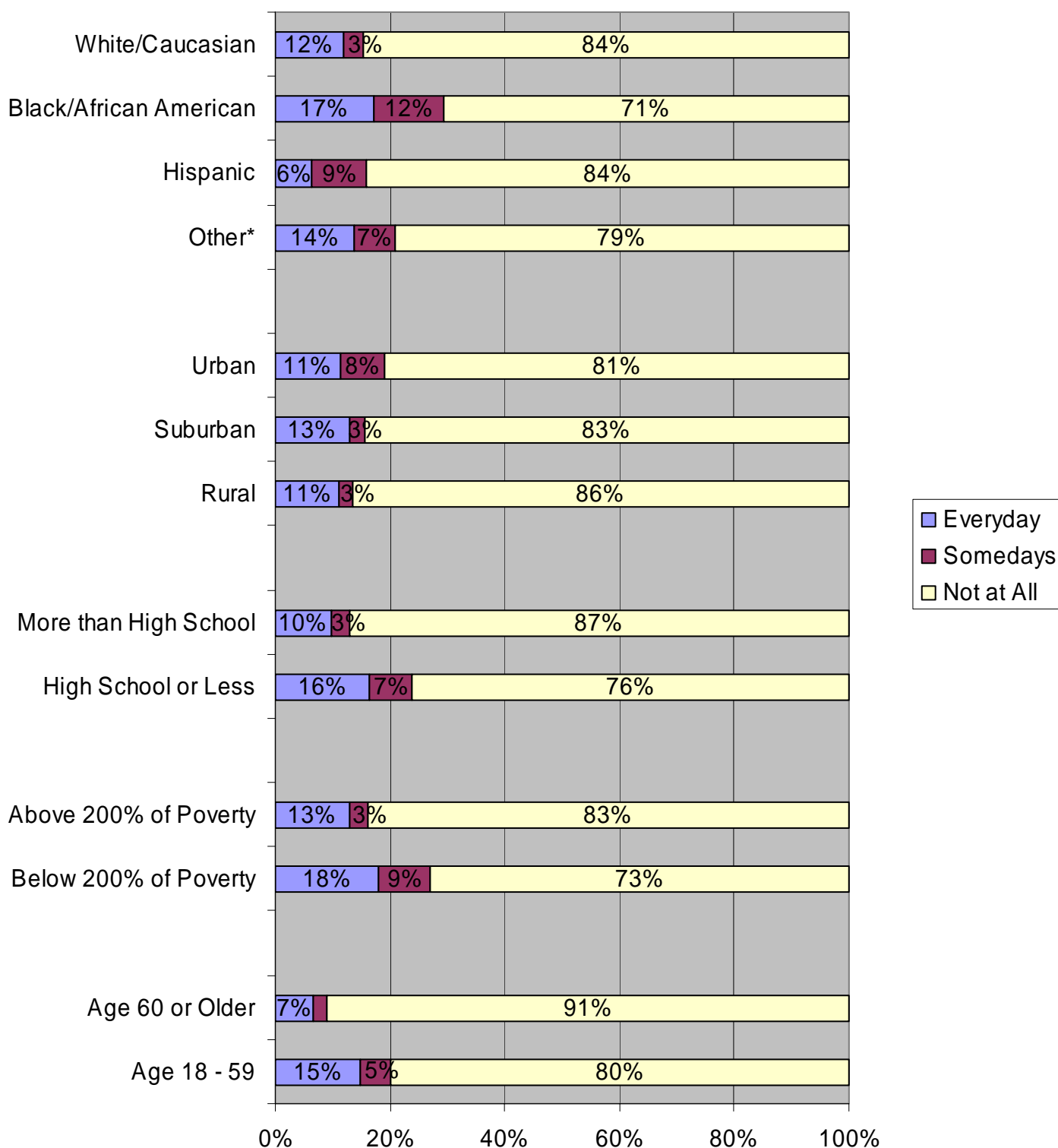
**Do you smoke cigarettes every day, some days, or not at all?

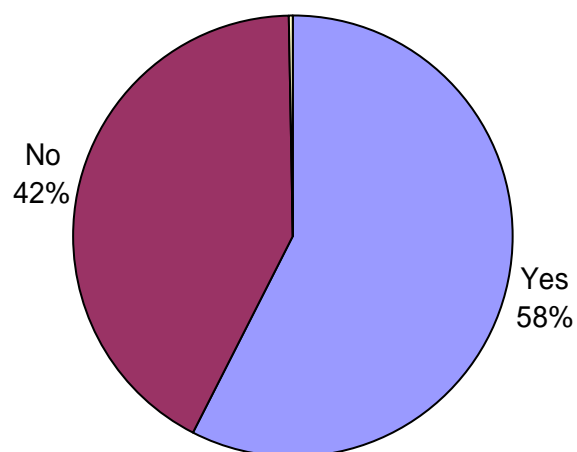

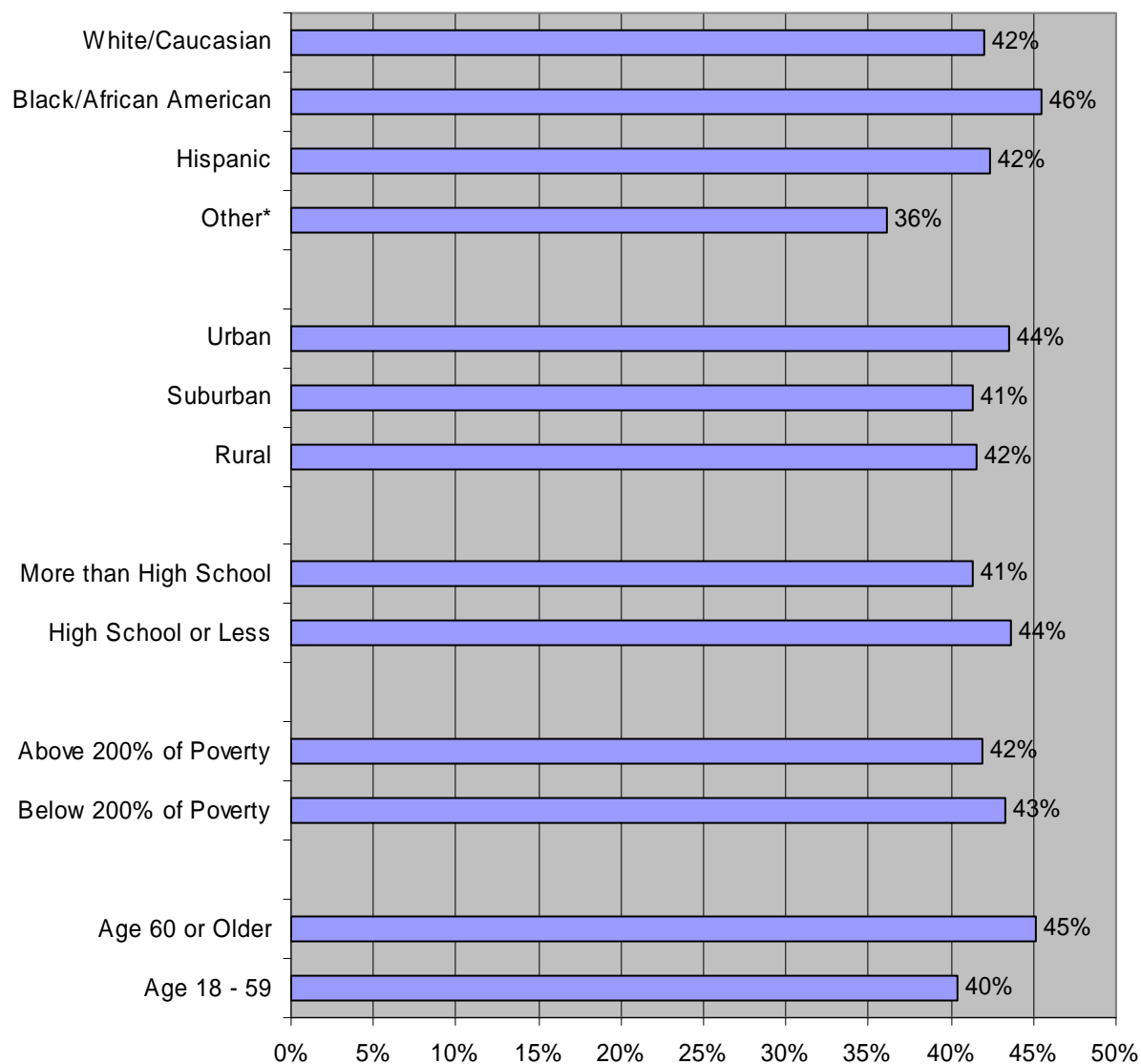
**Do you exercise at least 3 times a week for 30 minutes?

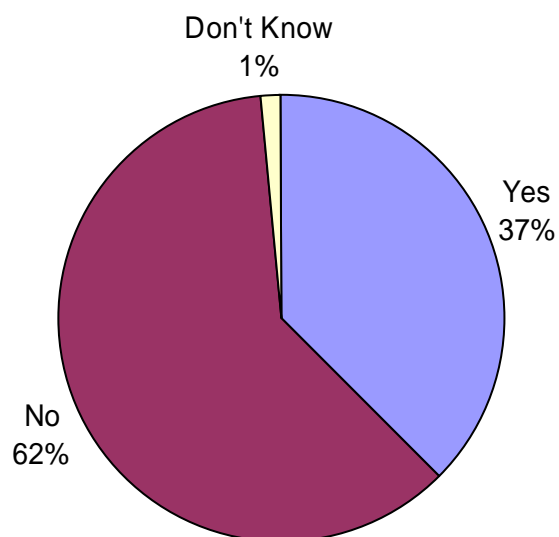

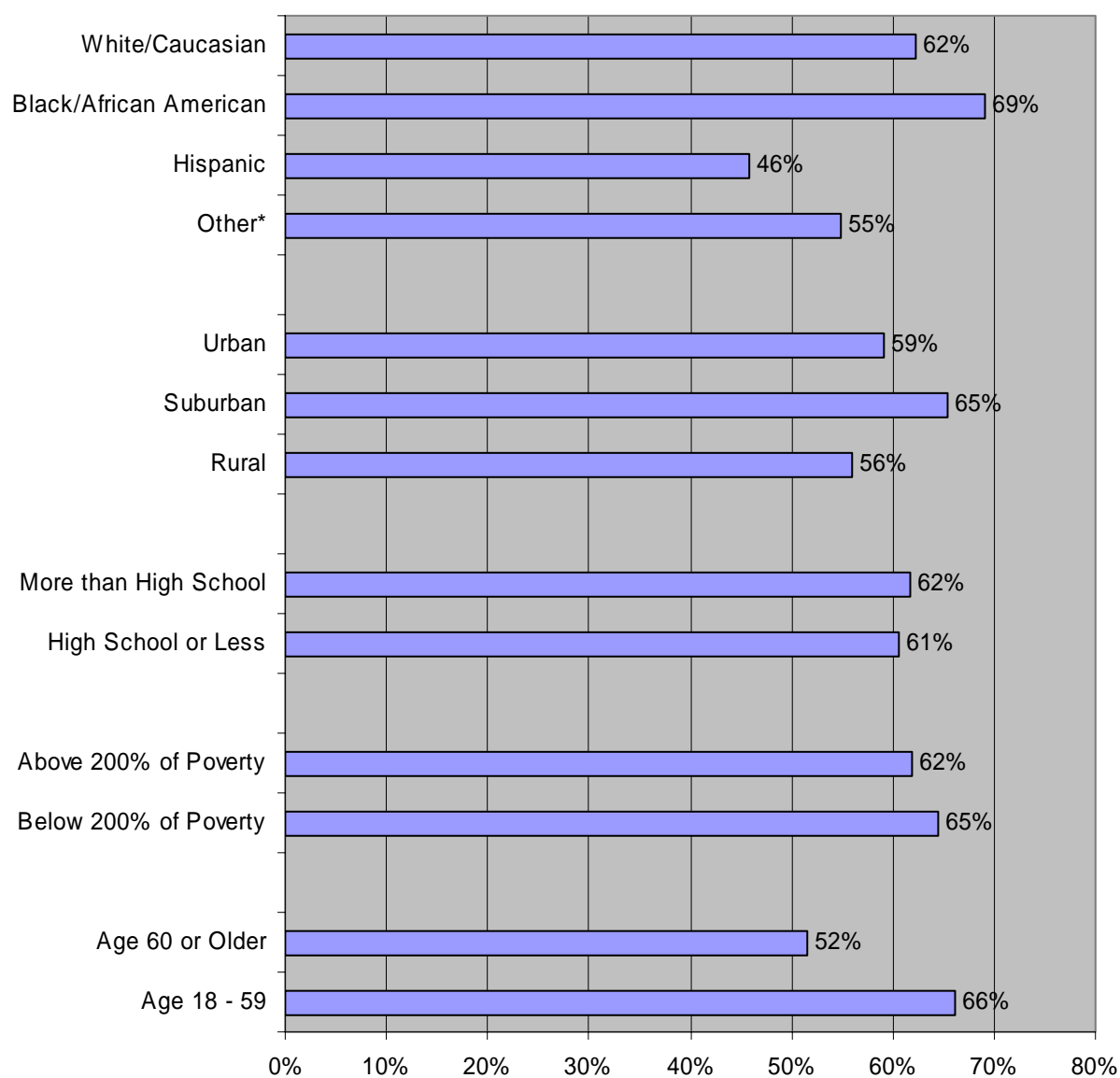
Do you eat 5 servings of fruits and vegetables every day?

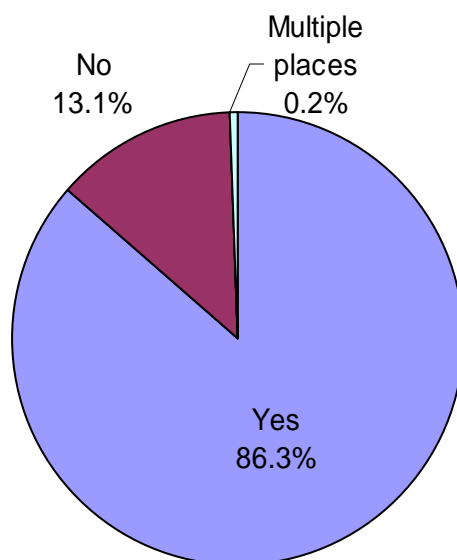

5 servings of fruits and vegetables every day.**



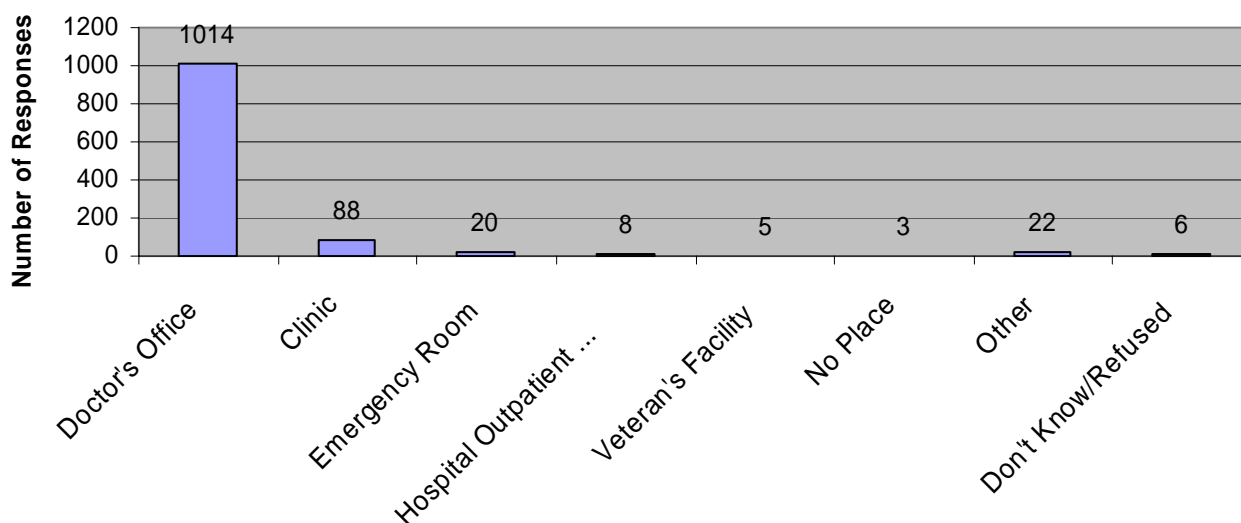

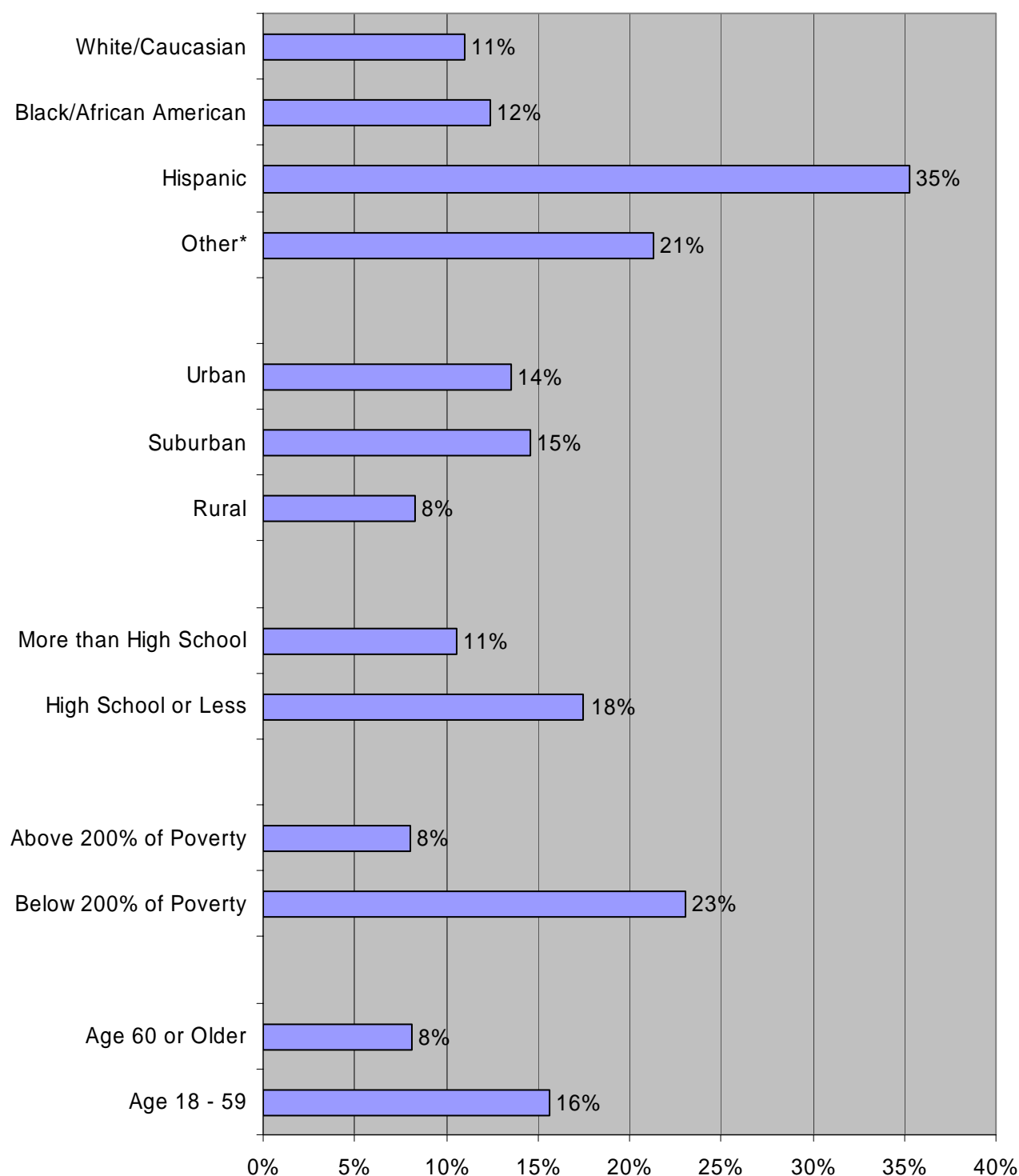
IF YES: What kind of place do you go most often?

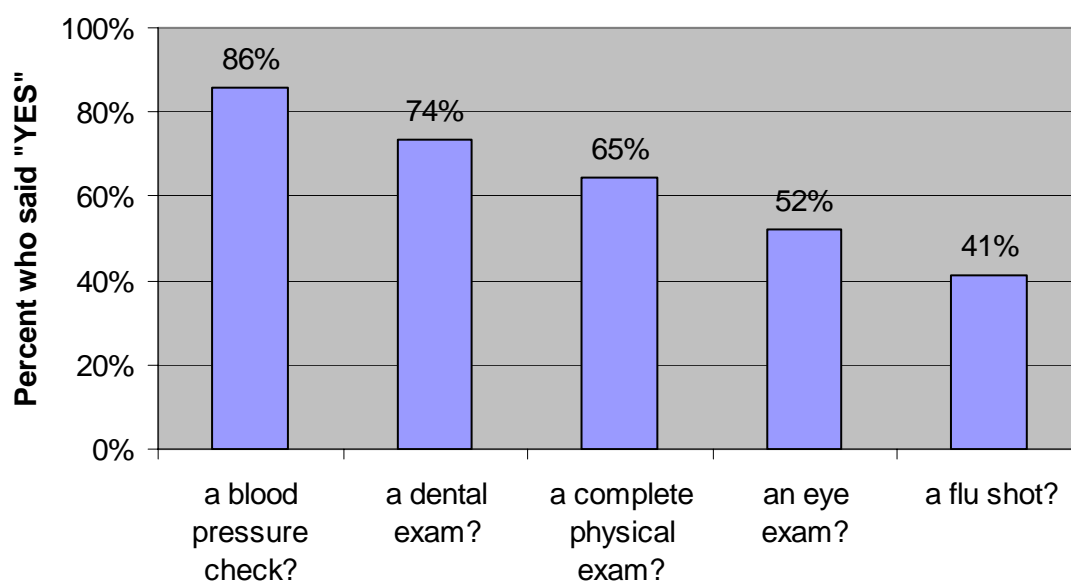

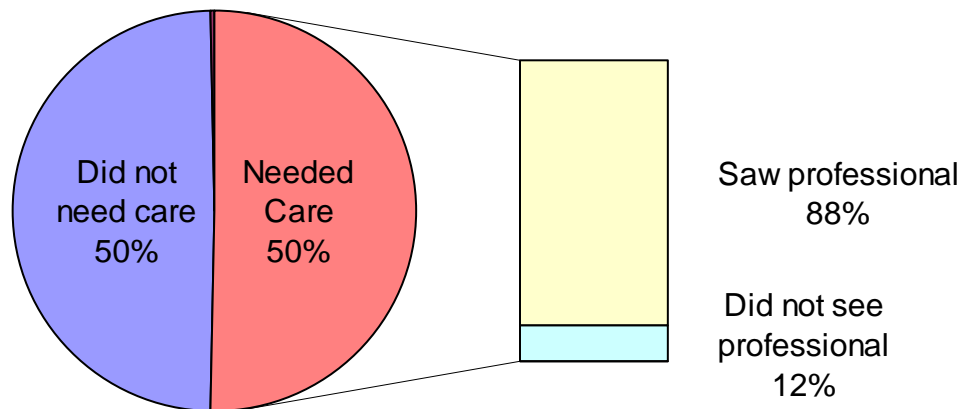

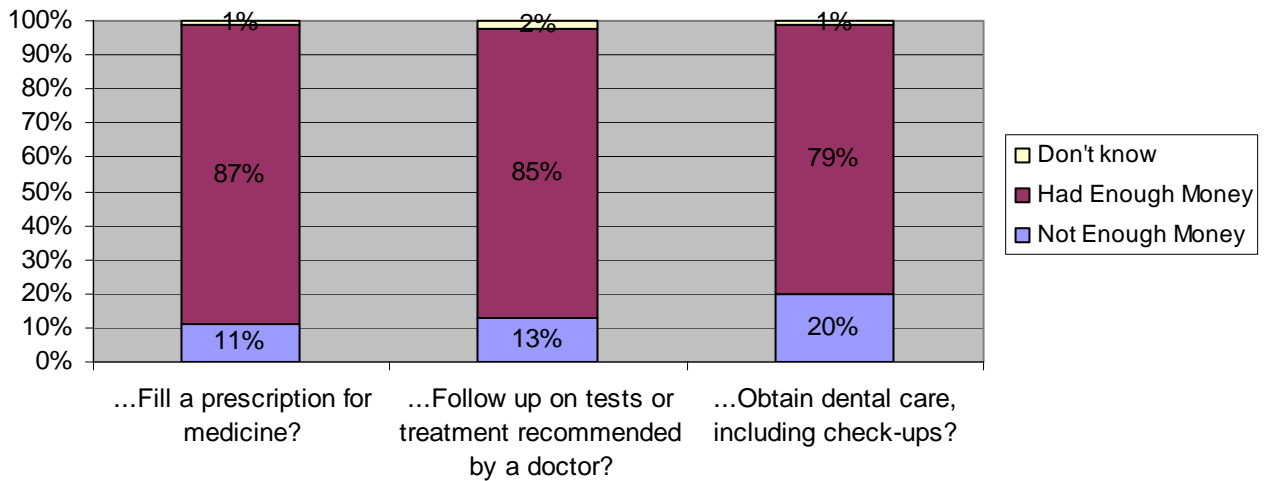
What was the main reason that you did not see a medical professional when needed?

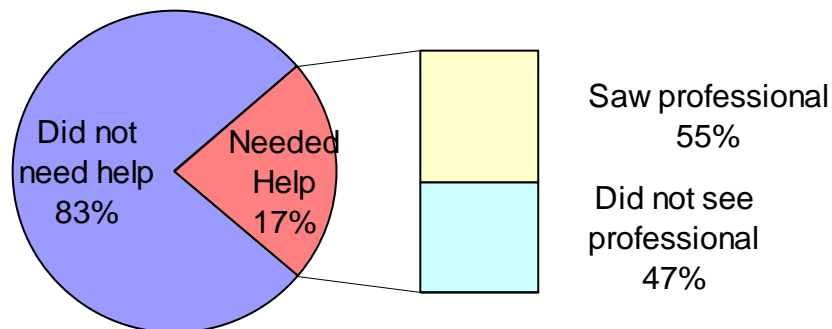

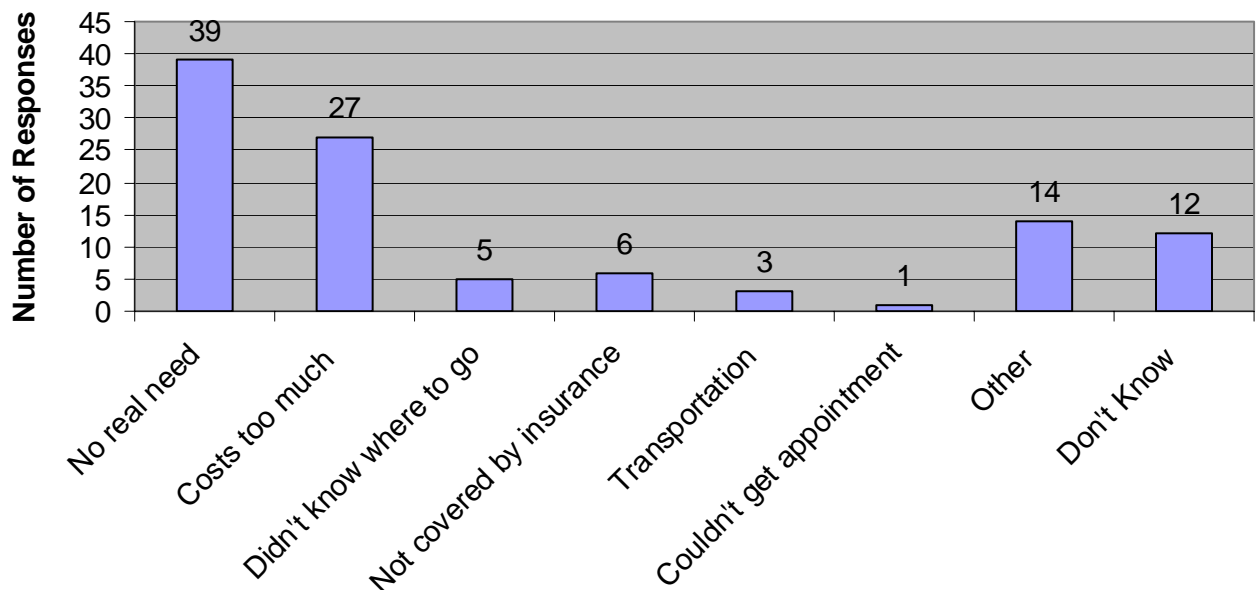

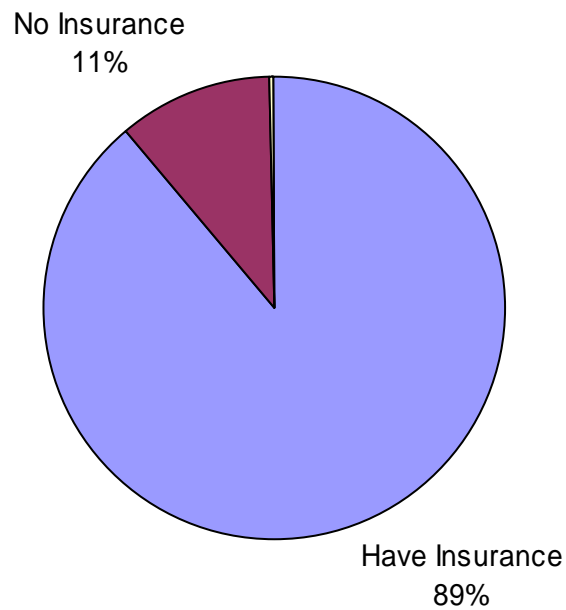
What was the main reason that you did not obtain the professional help or counseling?

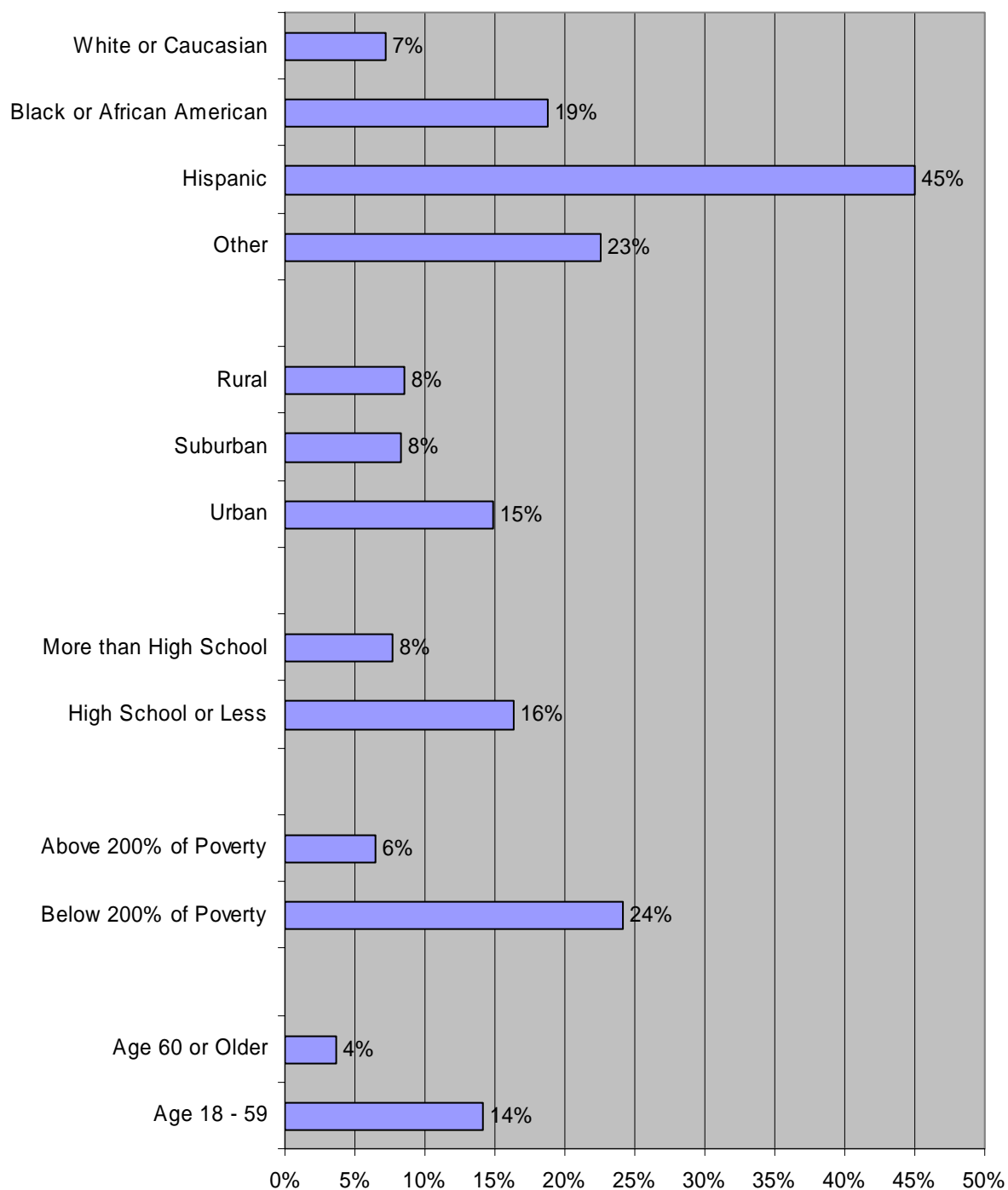
**Do you have any kind of health care coverage, including health insurance, prepaid plans such as HMO's, or government plans such as Medicare?

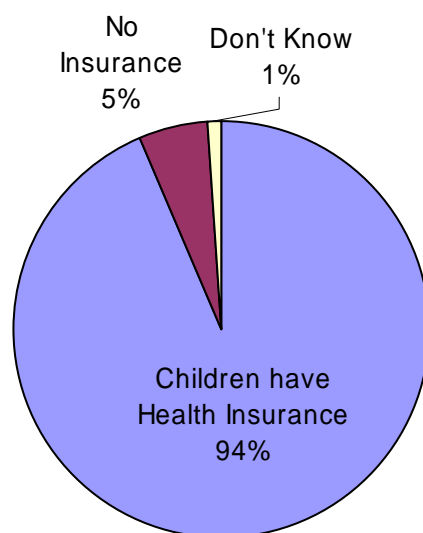

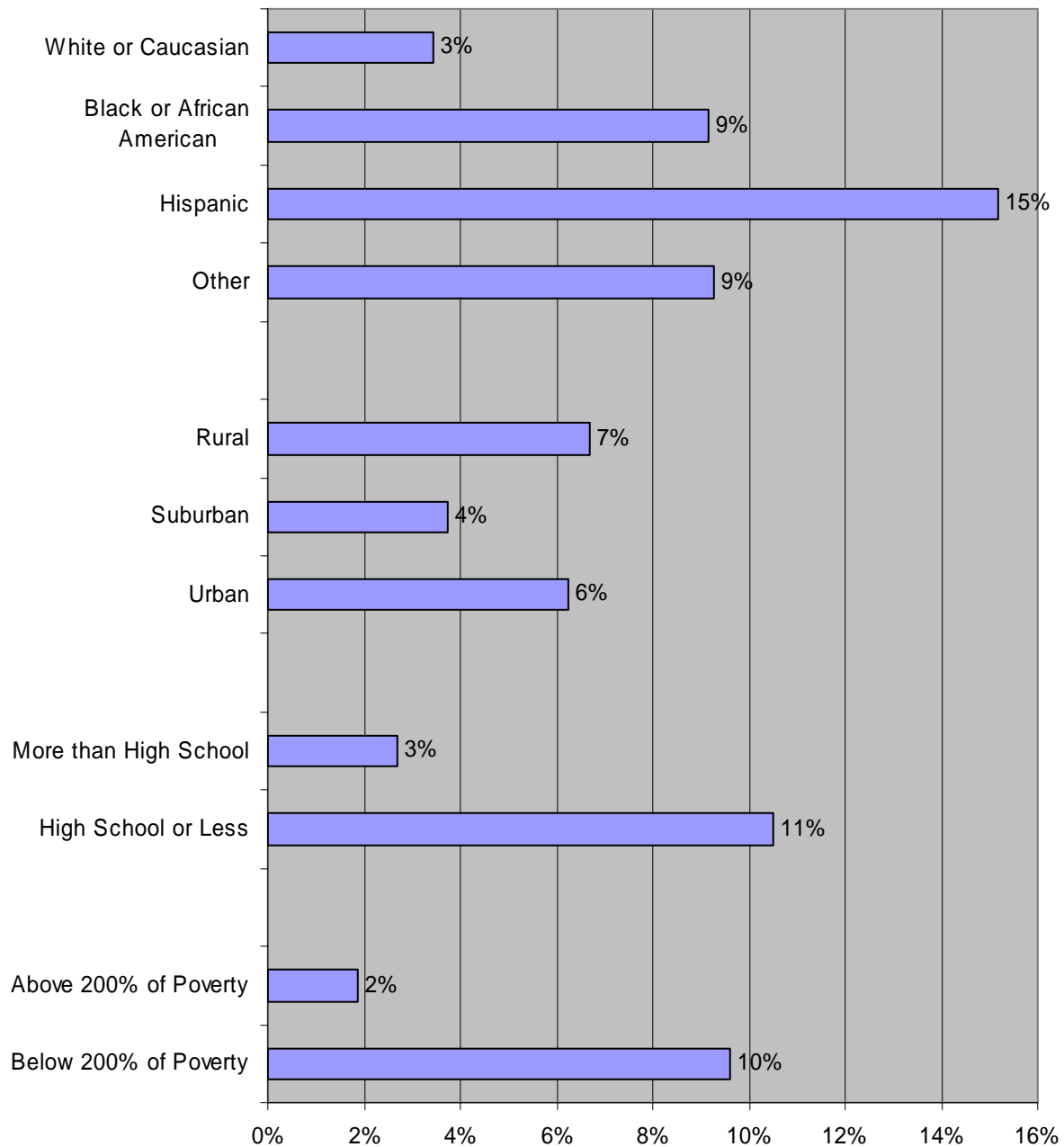
**Do your children (Ages 0 – 18) have health insurance?

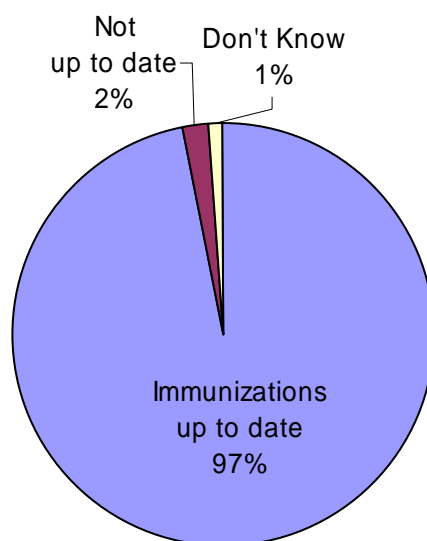

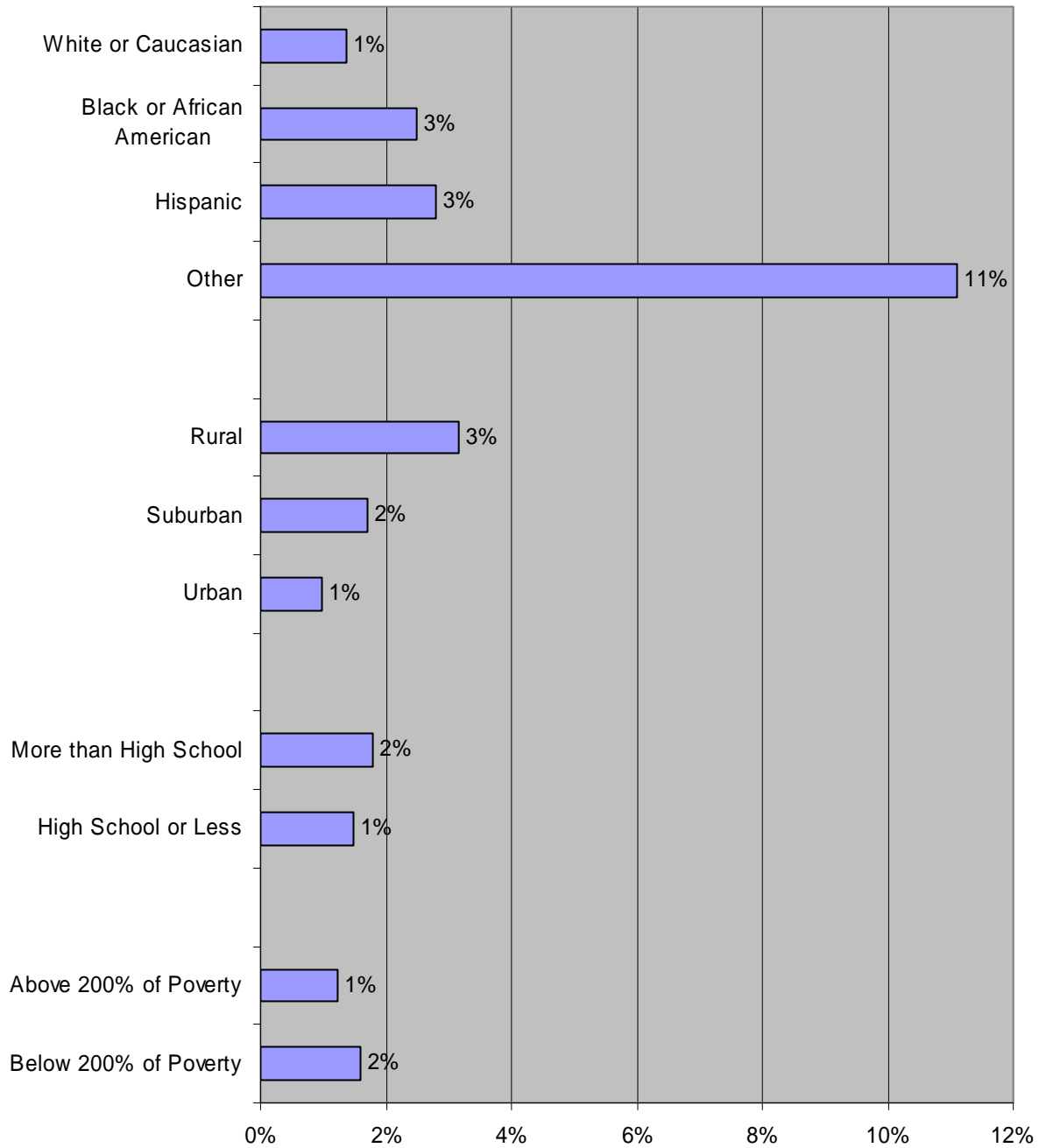
**Are your children's (Ages 0 – 18) immunizations up to date?

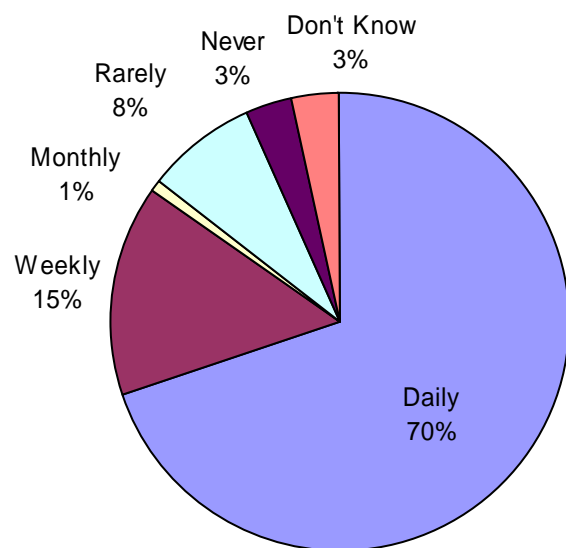

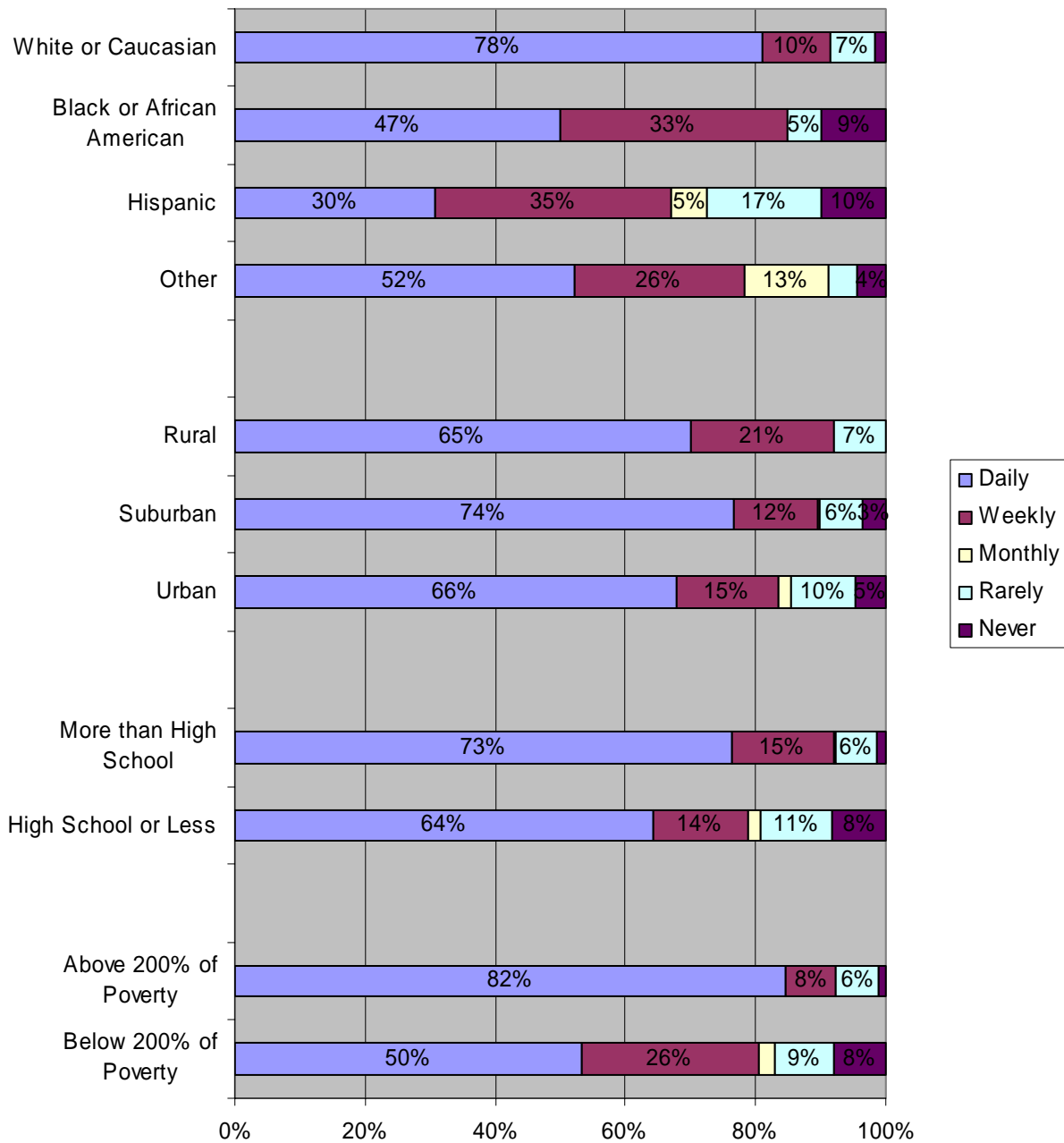
How often do you read to your children (Ages 0 – 5)? **Kent County 2006**

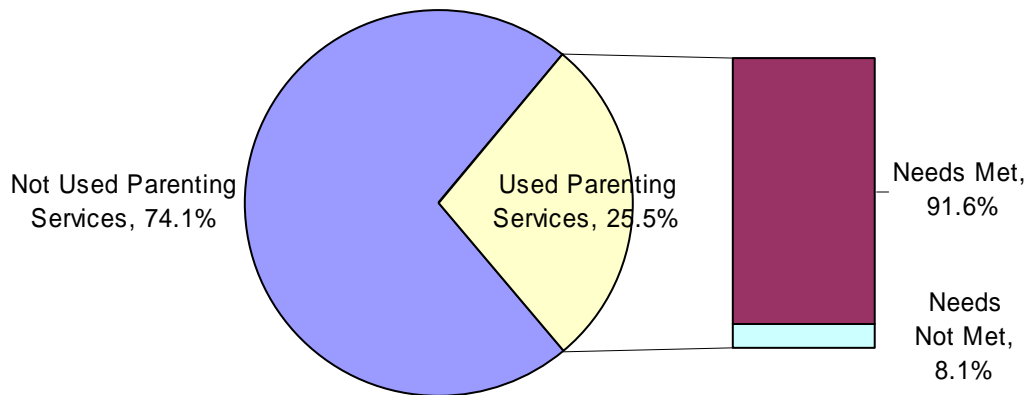

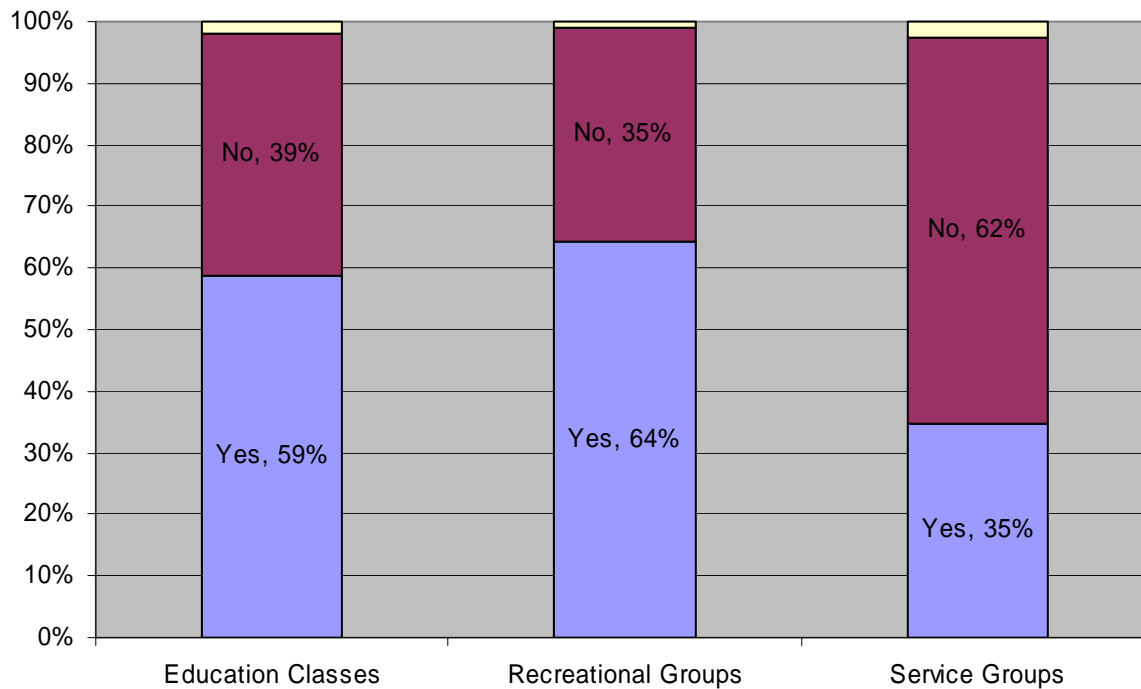

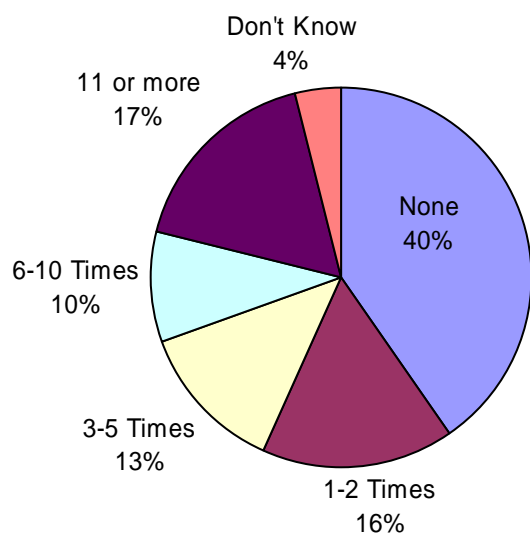

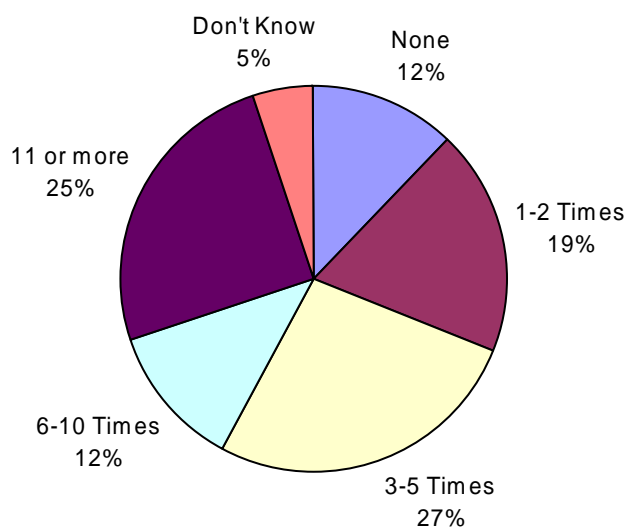

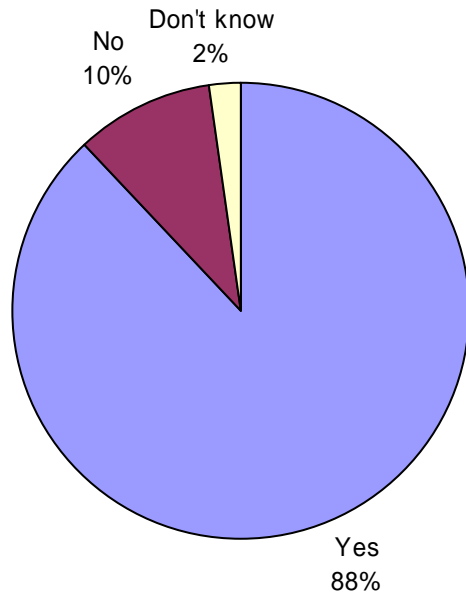

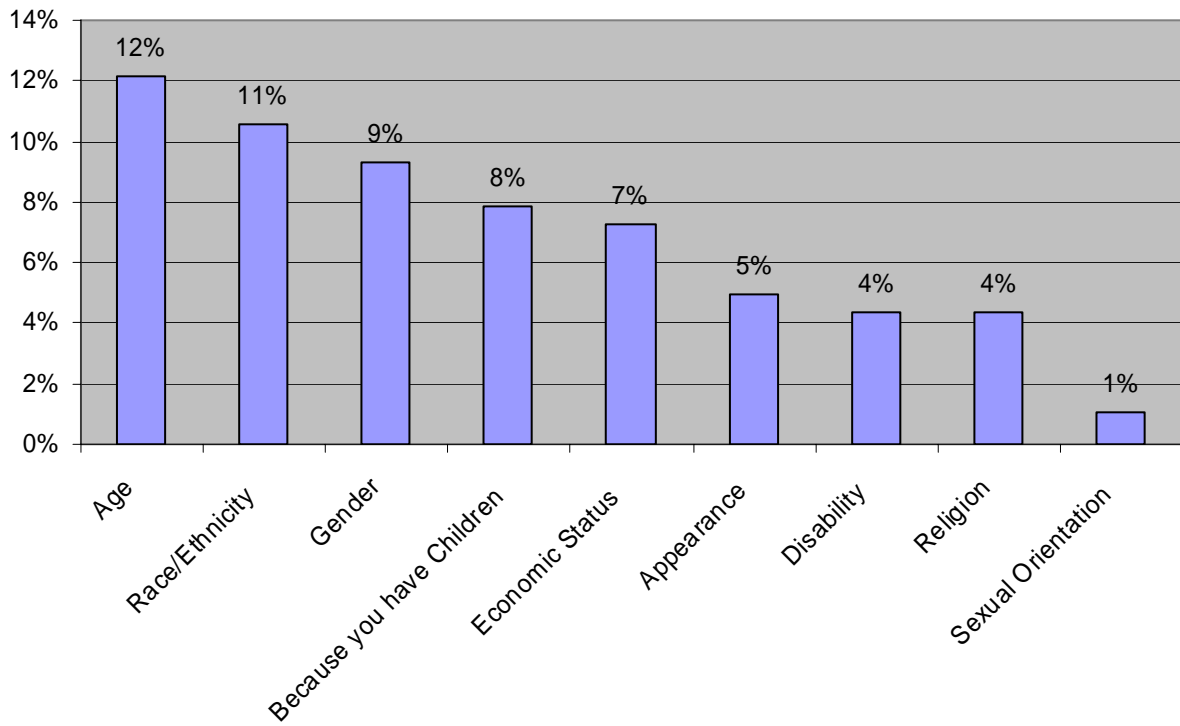

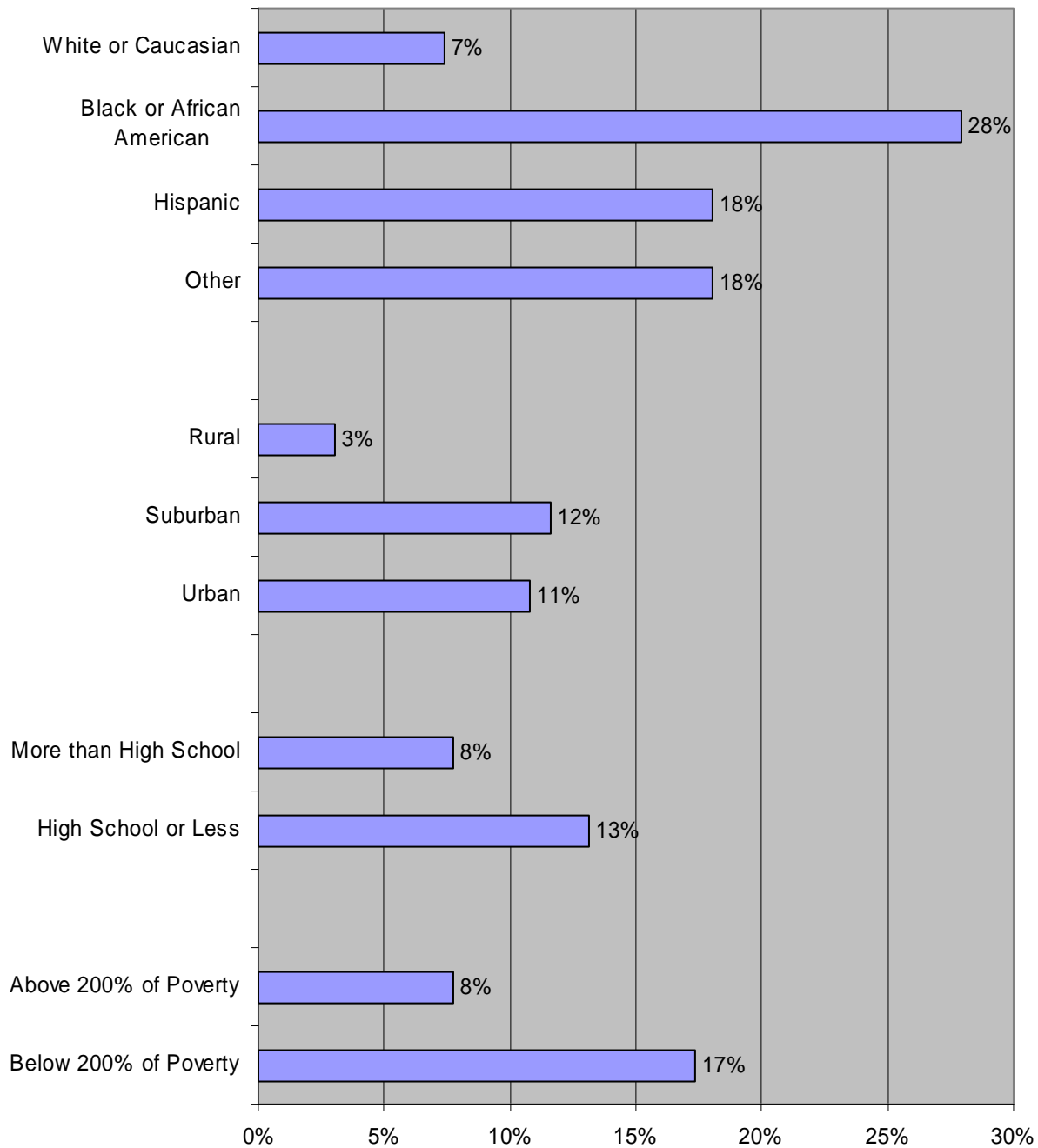
