## ROBERT HOOKER TO SUCCEED DOWNS ON BOARD OF CONTROL

Robert L. Hooker, president of Transnational Motors, Inc. of Grand Rapids, has been named to the Grand Valley State Board of Control. The appointment, announced by Gov. William G. Milliken, is subject to Senate confirmation.

Hooker, of 2654 Lake Drive S.E., Grand Rapids, succeeds Tom Downs of East Lansing, who resigned after serving on the board for eight years.

Hooker is a graduate of Calvin College and the University of Michigan, and a member of the

board of the Grand Valley Colleges Foundation and the Aquinas College President's Development Council. He is a board member and former president of the Opera Association of Western Michigan, the Grand Rapids Symphony Society, the National Alliance of Businessmen and Junior Achievement.

He has also served as a board member for the Arts Council of Grand Rapids, the Mayor's Cultural Committee, the Civic Center Project Study and Coordination Committee, and has held numerous other public service positions.

Hooker's appointment is for the remainder of a term expiring December 31, 1984.

His predecessor, Downs, 65, was named to the board in June, 1974, to complete a term expiring in December, 1976. In 1977 Downs was reappointed to an eight-year term expiring in 1984. Downs has served as vice chairman of the board since 1977.

Downs said he is leaving the board because other commitments prevent him from attending board meetings regularly.

### COLLEGE-COMMUNITY BAND TO PERFORM

The Grand Valley Summer College-Community Band will present the final concert in its summer series Tuesday, July 27. The 75-piece group will perform at 7:30 p.m. in the Calder Fine Arts Center.

Members of the band represent a diverse selection of ages and experience, including both professional and amateur musicians ranging from aspiring high school seniors to retirees. The group rehearses once a week during the summer.

The free concert will feature a variety of musical styles, including familiar marches, according to Director William Root. Sue Schuiling Roh will sing "Summertime" as a part of the George Gershwin selections from "Porgy and Bess." Other numbers will include "Variations on a Korean Folk Song" by John Barnes Chance; "Raiders of the Lost Ark," John Williams; and the perennial favorite finale, "The Stars and Stripes Forever," by John Philip Sousa.
