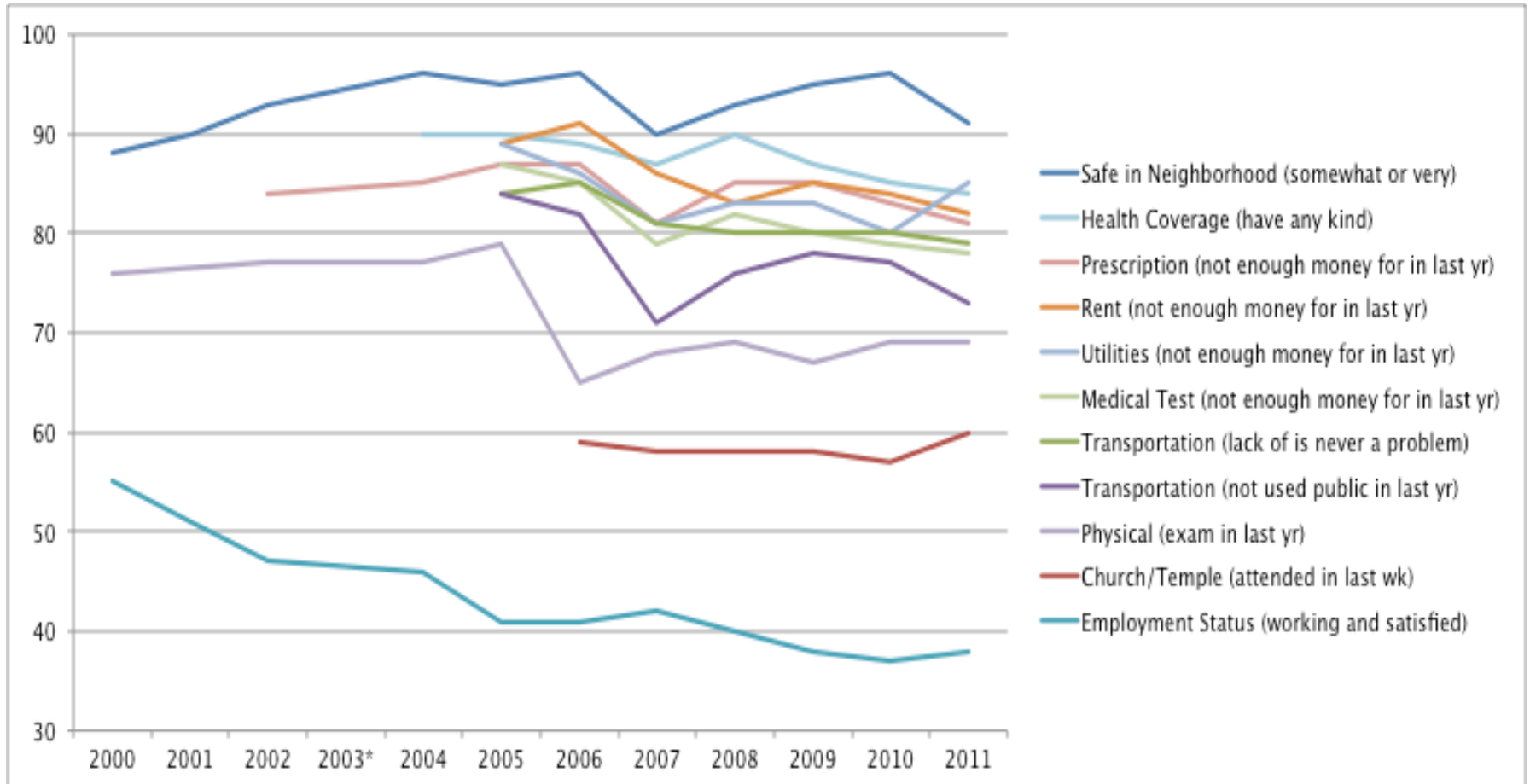

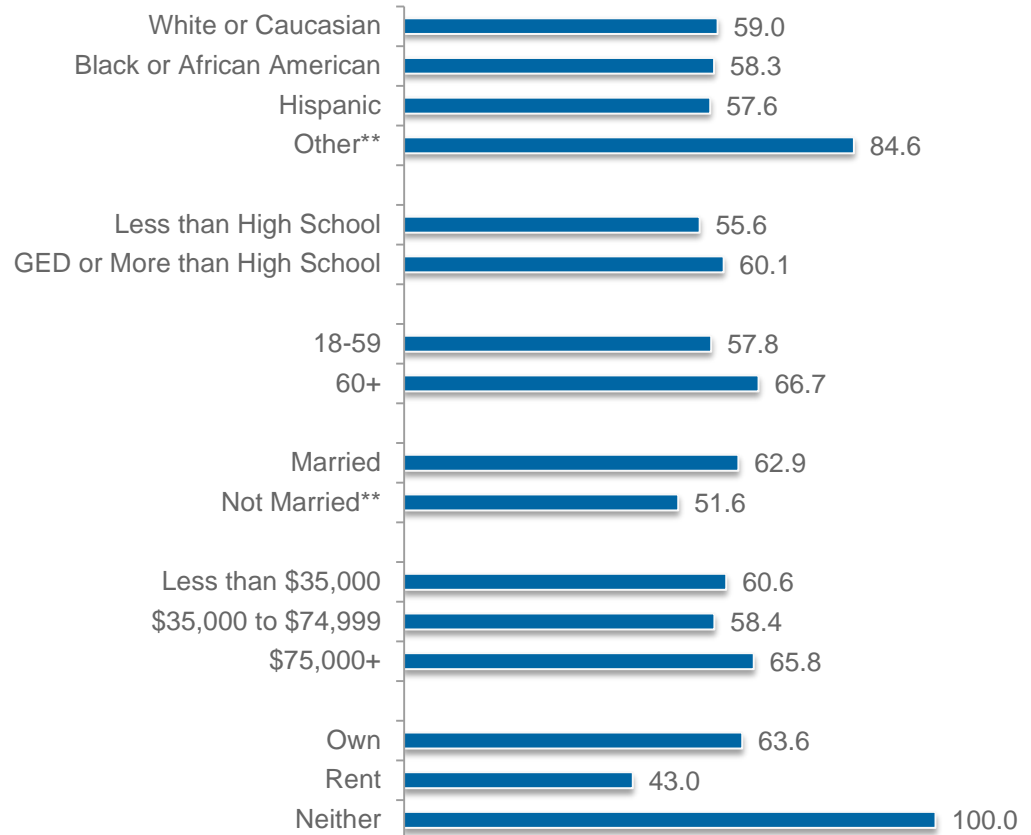
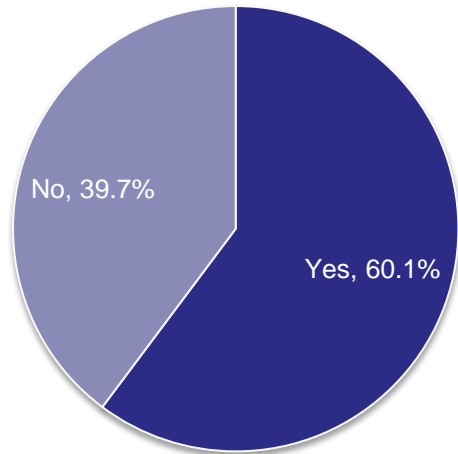
Results – Civic Engagement

- Belong to local groups, clubs, or associations



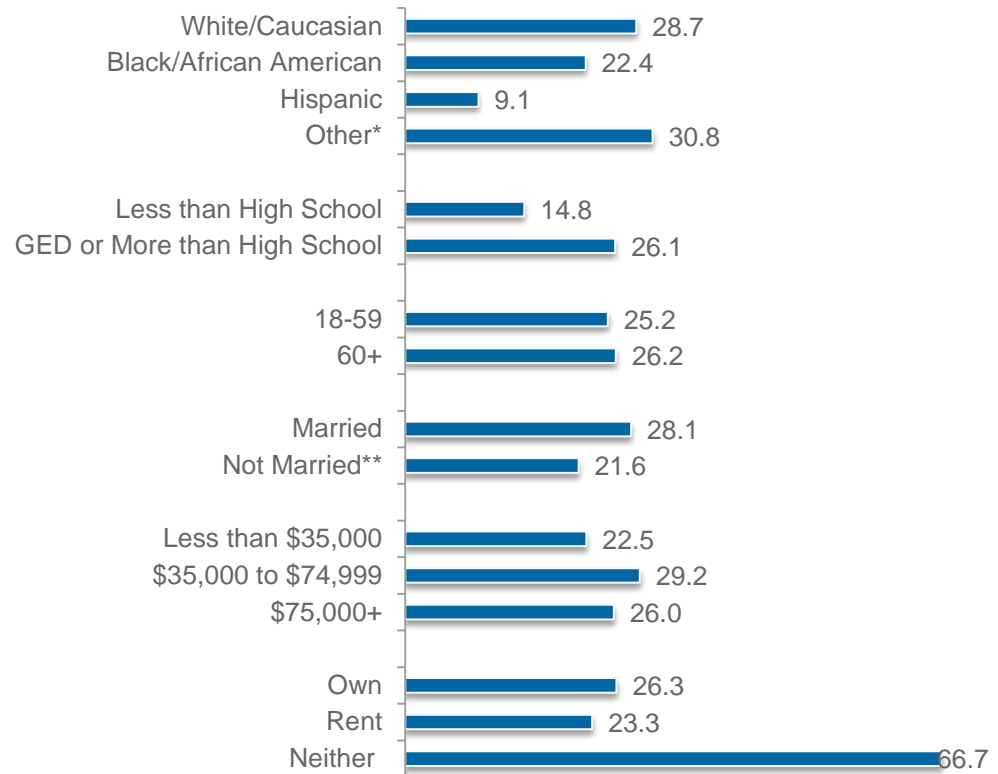
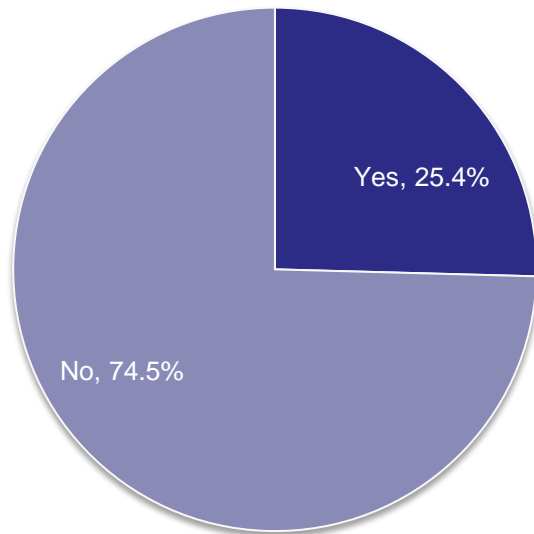
Results – Civic Engagement

During the past week, did you Go to church, temple, or another place of worship for services or other activities?



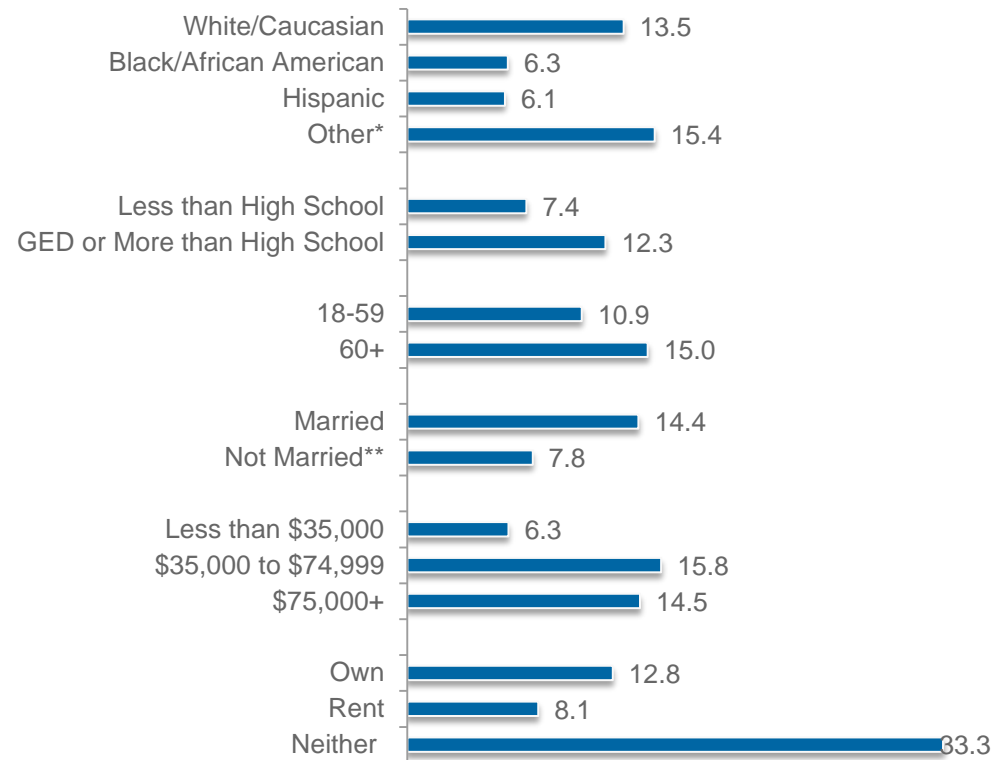
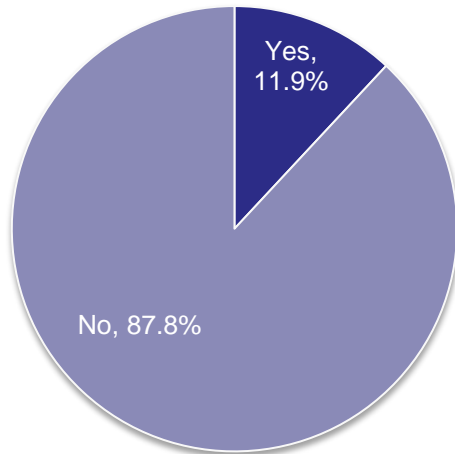
Results – Civic Engagement

In the past 12 months have you contacted or visited a public official - at any level of government - to ask for assistance or to express your opinion?



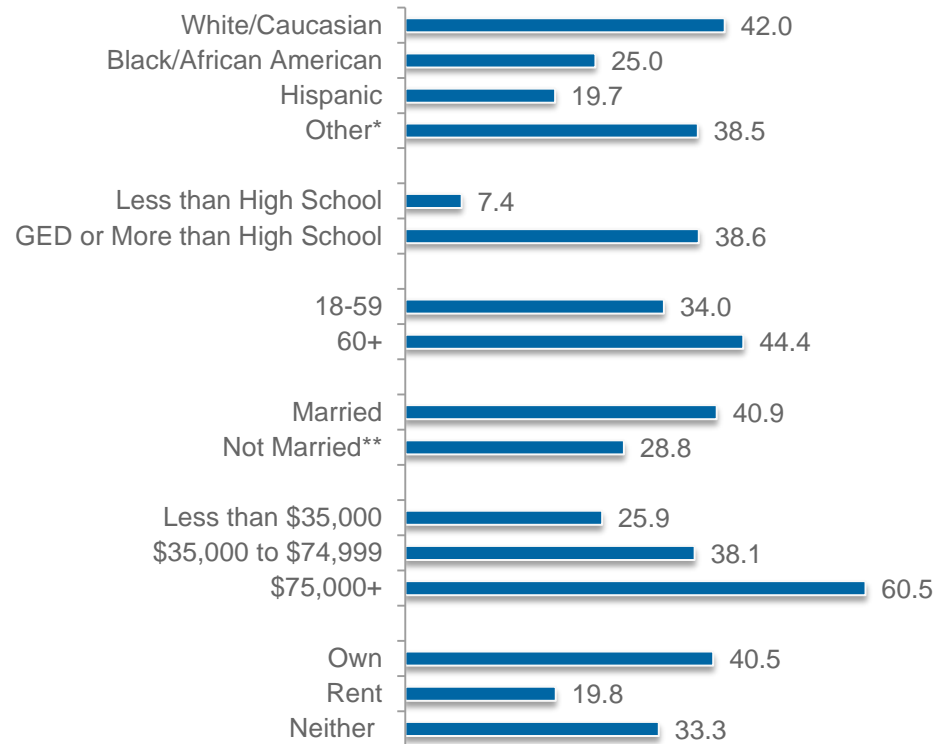
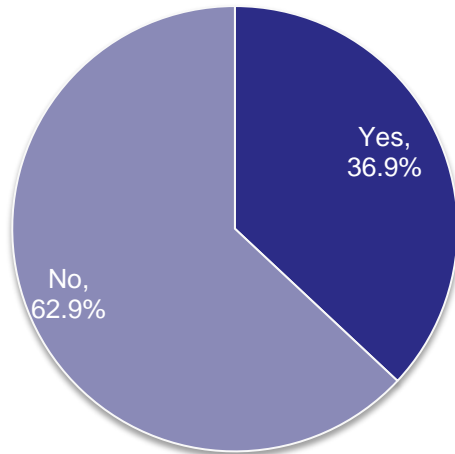

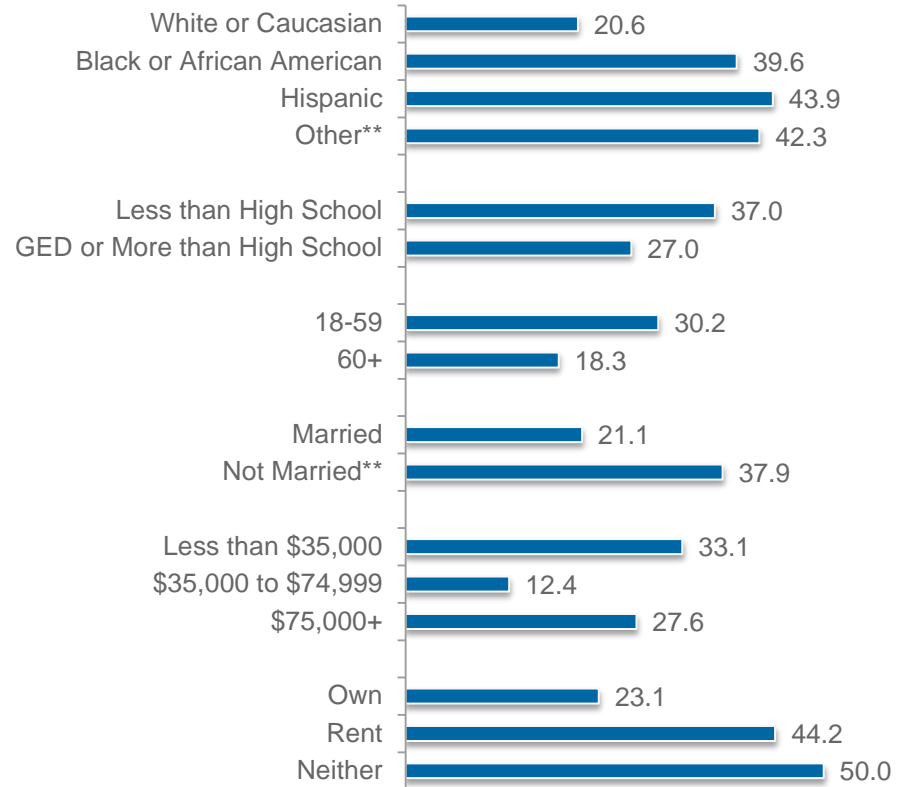
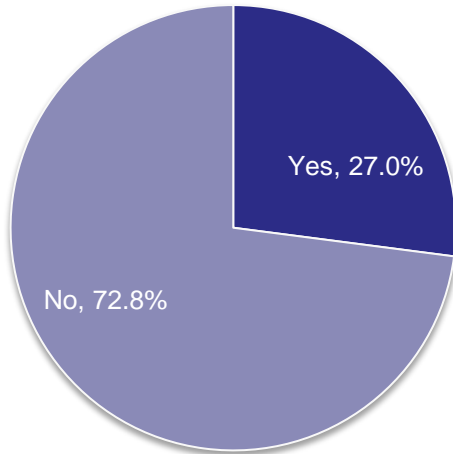
Results – Basic Needs

- Lack of transportation a problem
- Use public transportation
- Current employment status
- Enough money to take care of your necessities
- Worry about running out of money for food or clothing
- Cut the size of your meals/skip meals
- Worry about running out of money for shelter
- Enough money to pay rent, mortgage, or real estate taxes
- Evicted for nonpayment
- Enough money to pay utility bills
- Gas, electric or oil disconnected
- Telephone disconnected
- Enough money to fill a prescription for medicine
- Enough money to follow up on medical tests/treatment
- Enough money to obtain dental care/check-ups



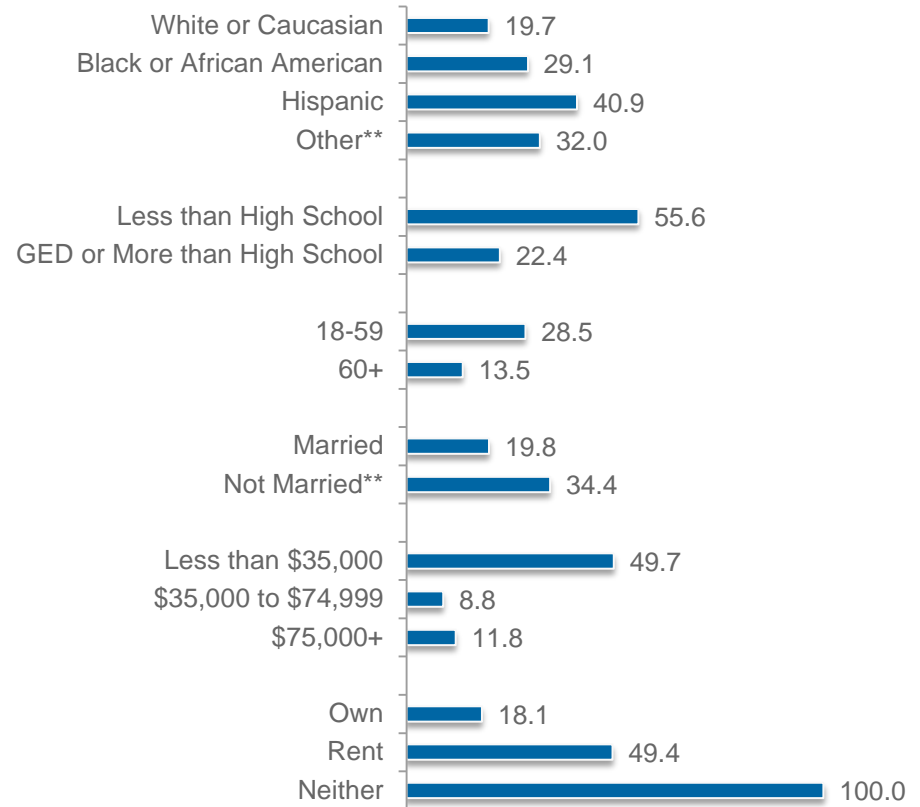
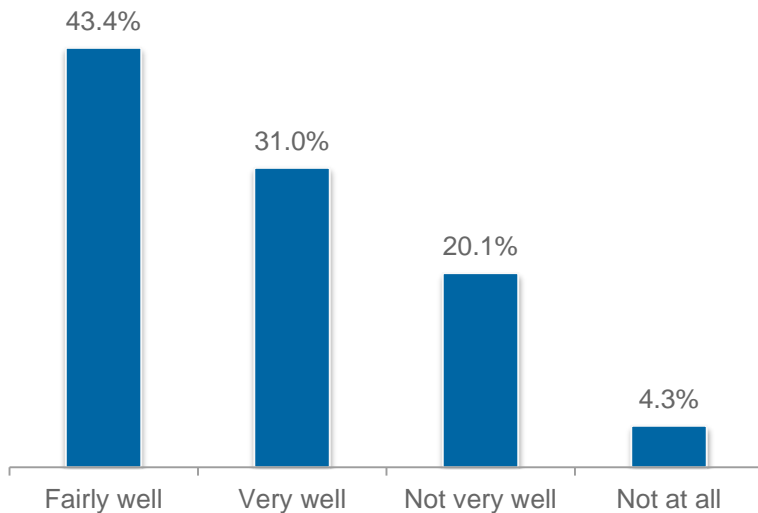

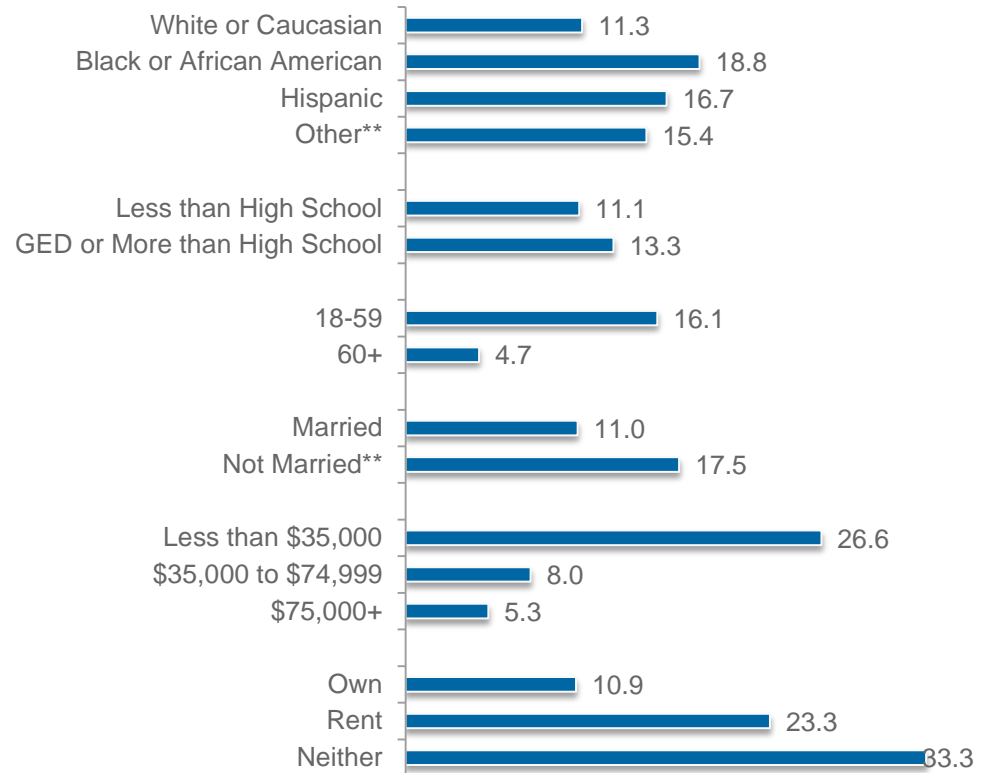
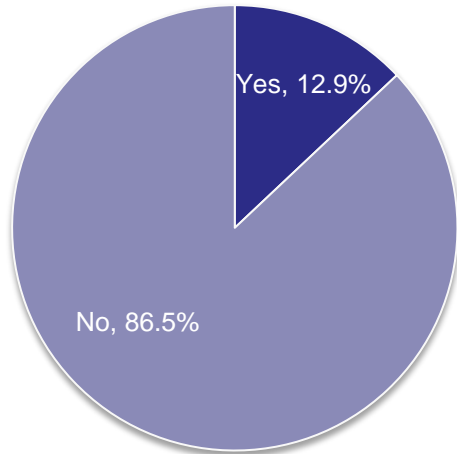
How well does the amount of money you have take care of your necessities?

In the last 12 months, did you or others in your household ever cut the size of your meals or skip meals because there wasn't enough money for food?



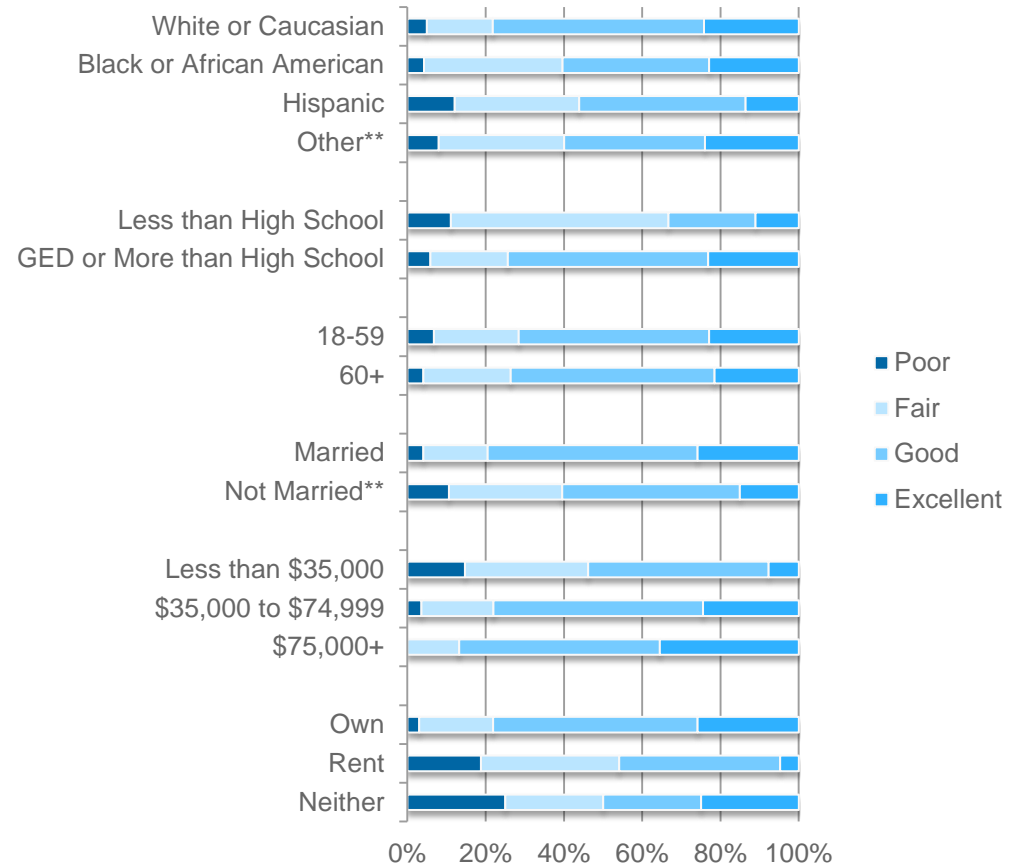
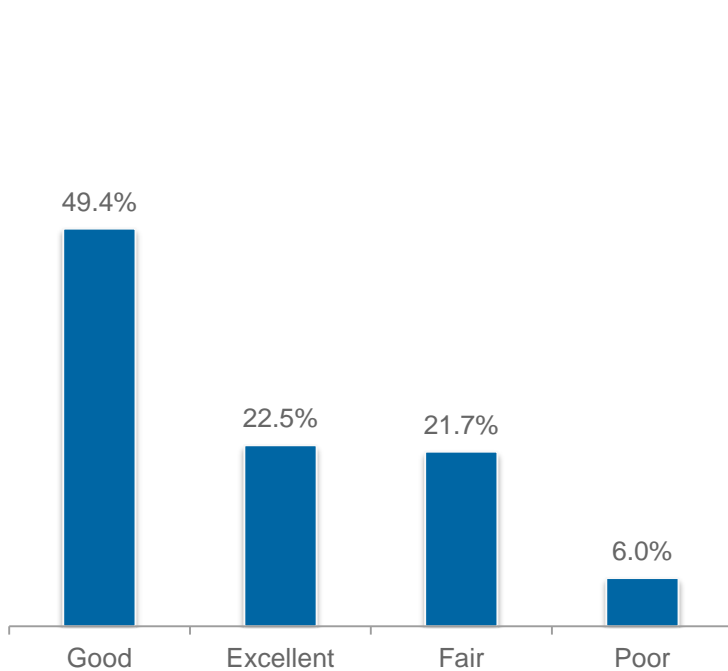
Results – Health

- Any kind of health care coverage



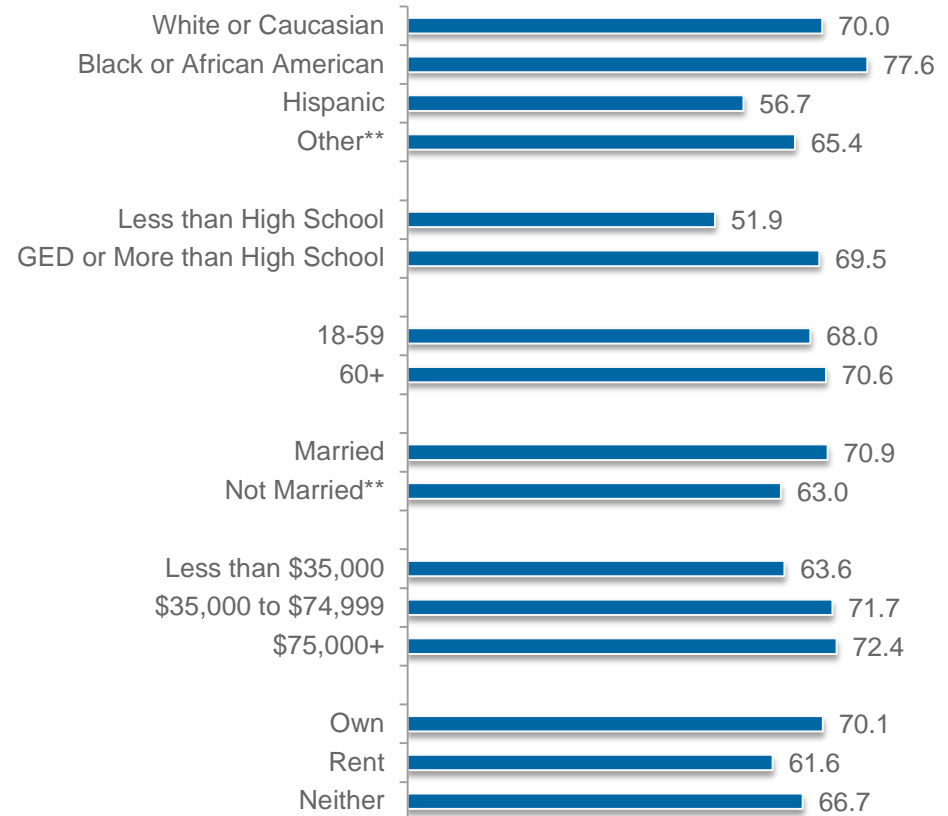
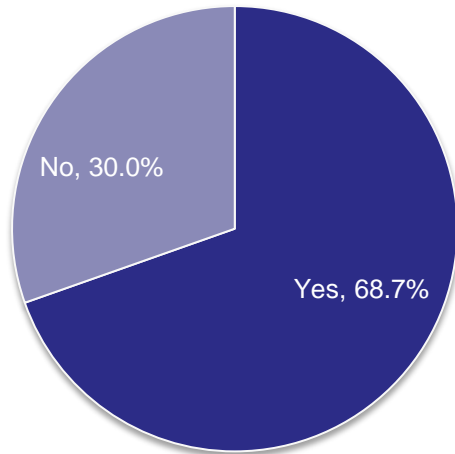

How would you rate your health?



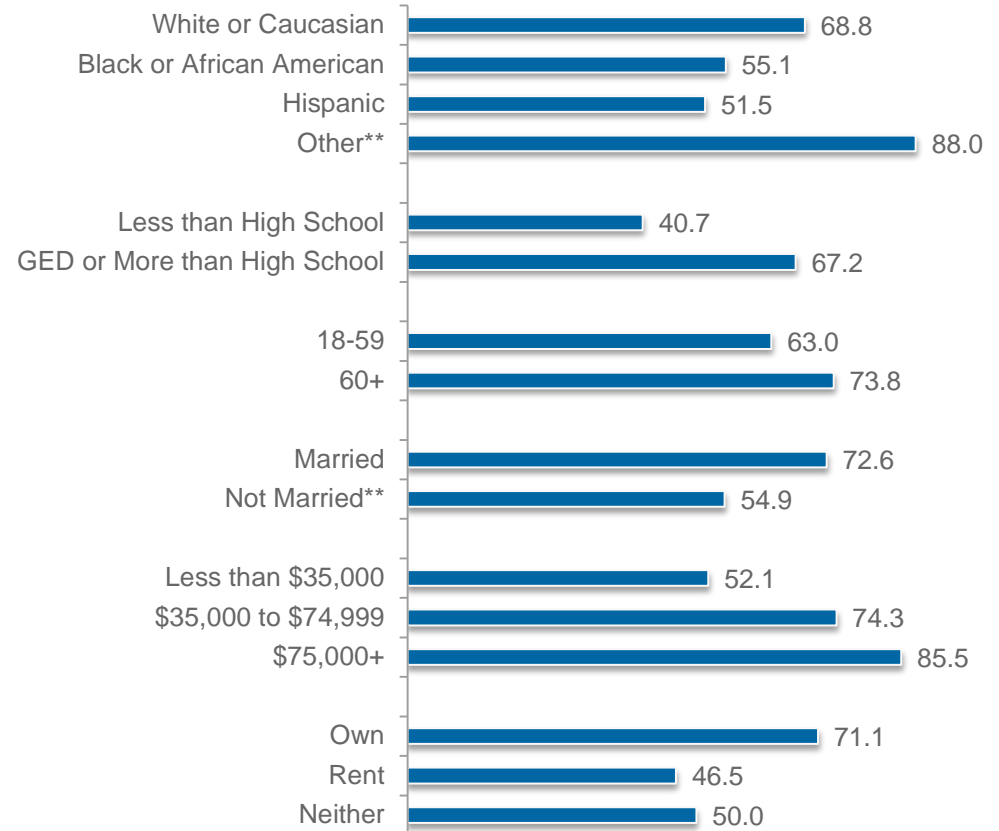
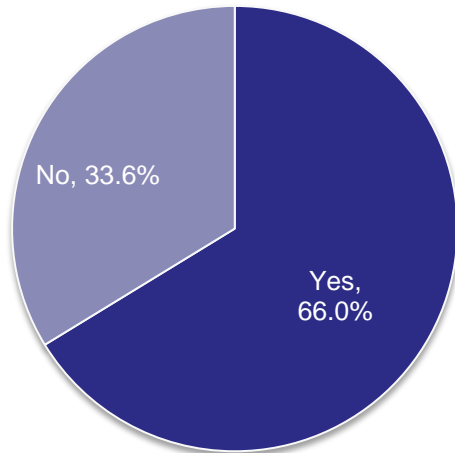

During the past 12 months, have you had a dental exam?

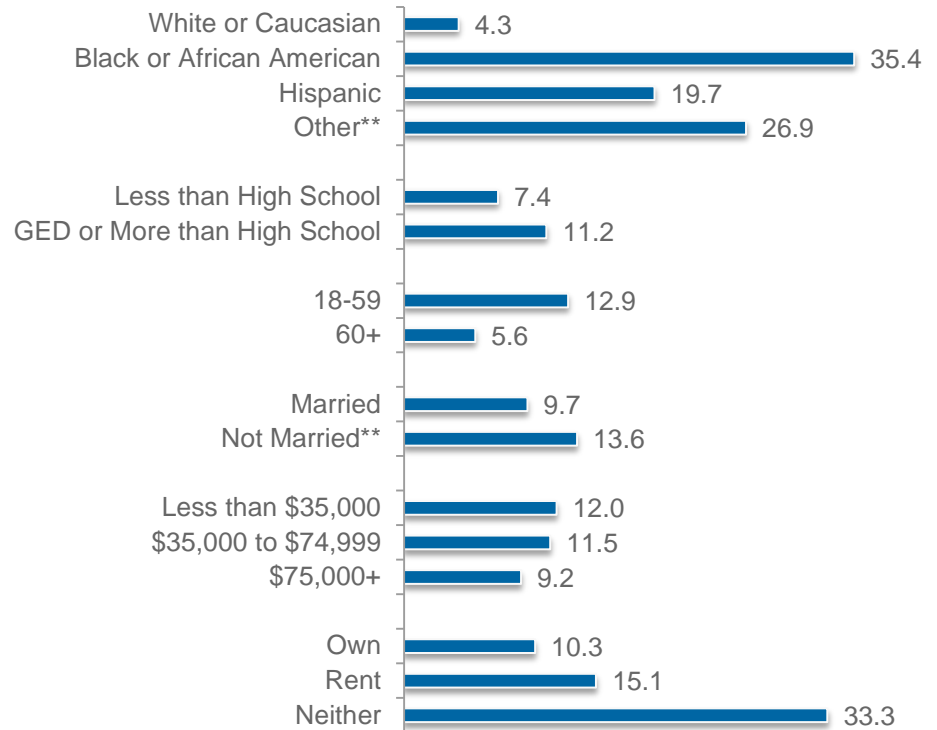
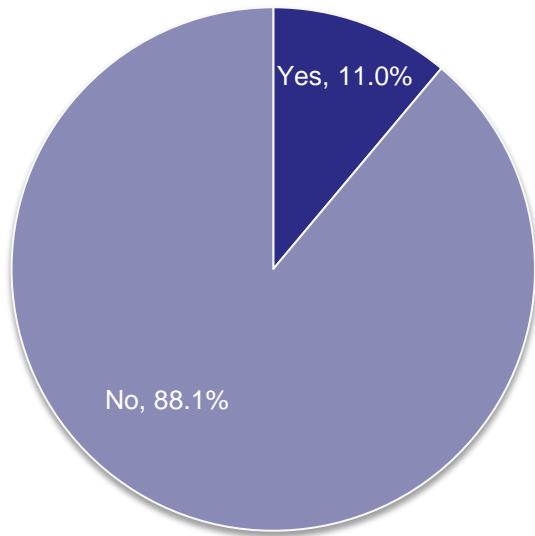

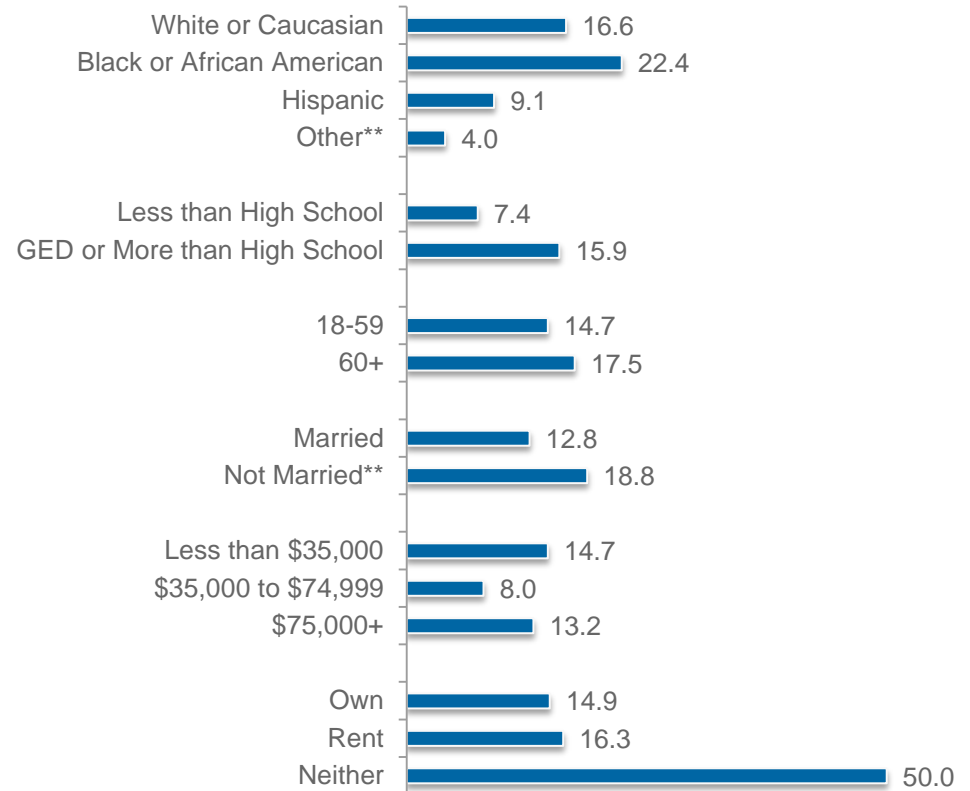
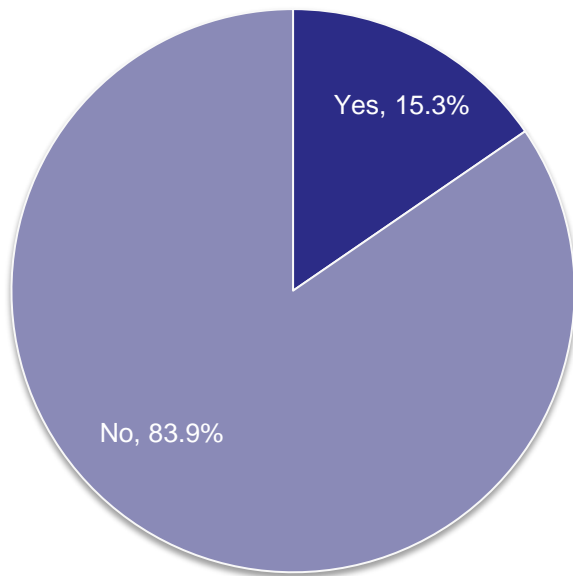

In the past year, have you felt that you were discriminated against for any of the following reasons . . . race or ethnicity?



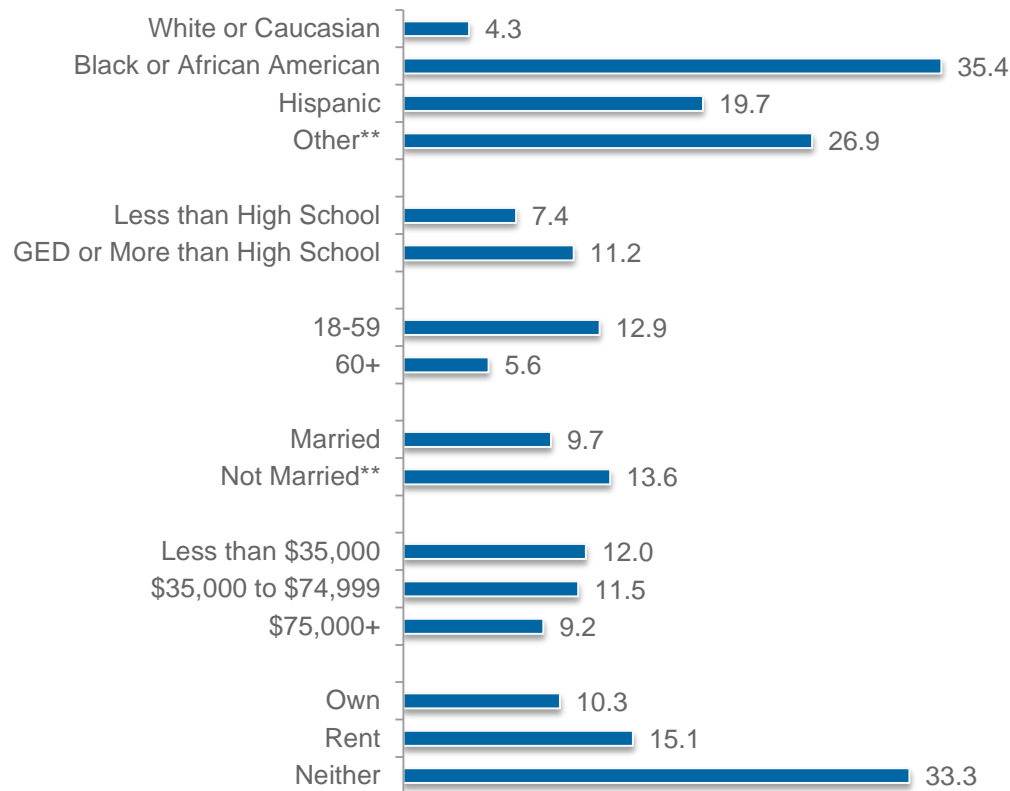

In the past year, have you felt that you were discriminated against for any of the following reasons . . . race or ethnicity (percent of demographic categories answering yes)?

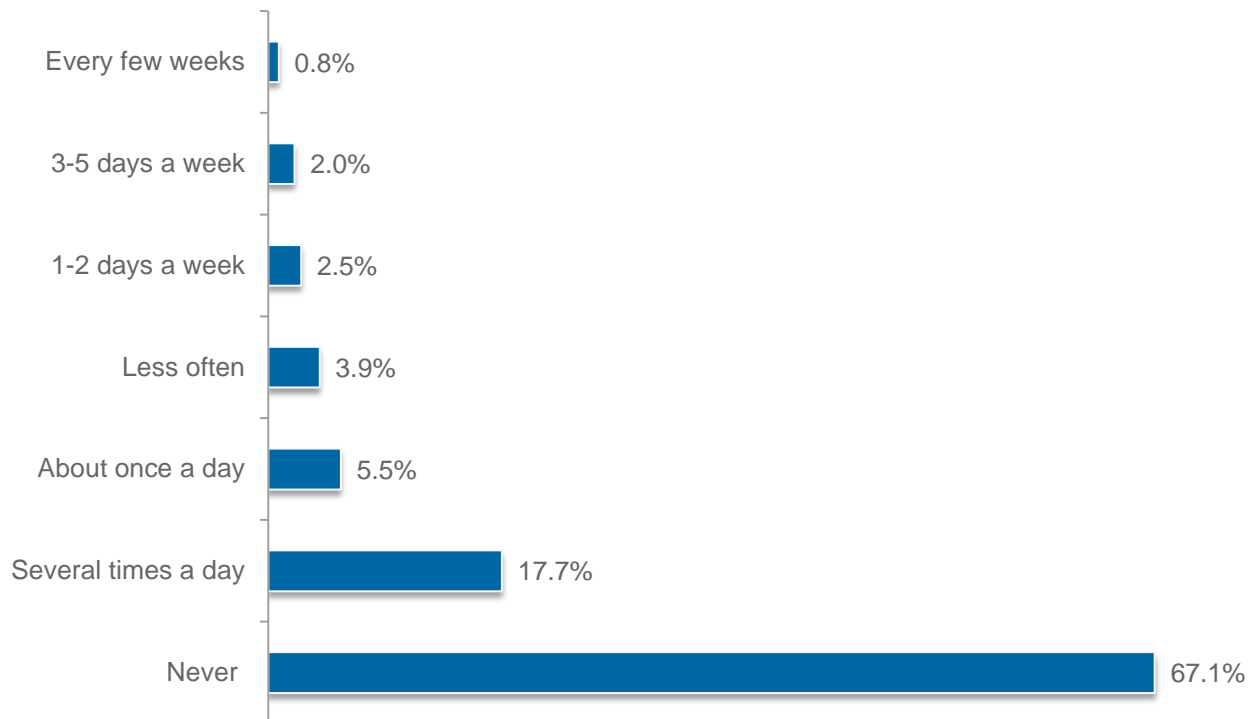

- Ever used the Internet to contribute to charitable organization or nonprofit

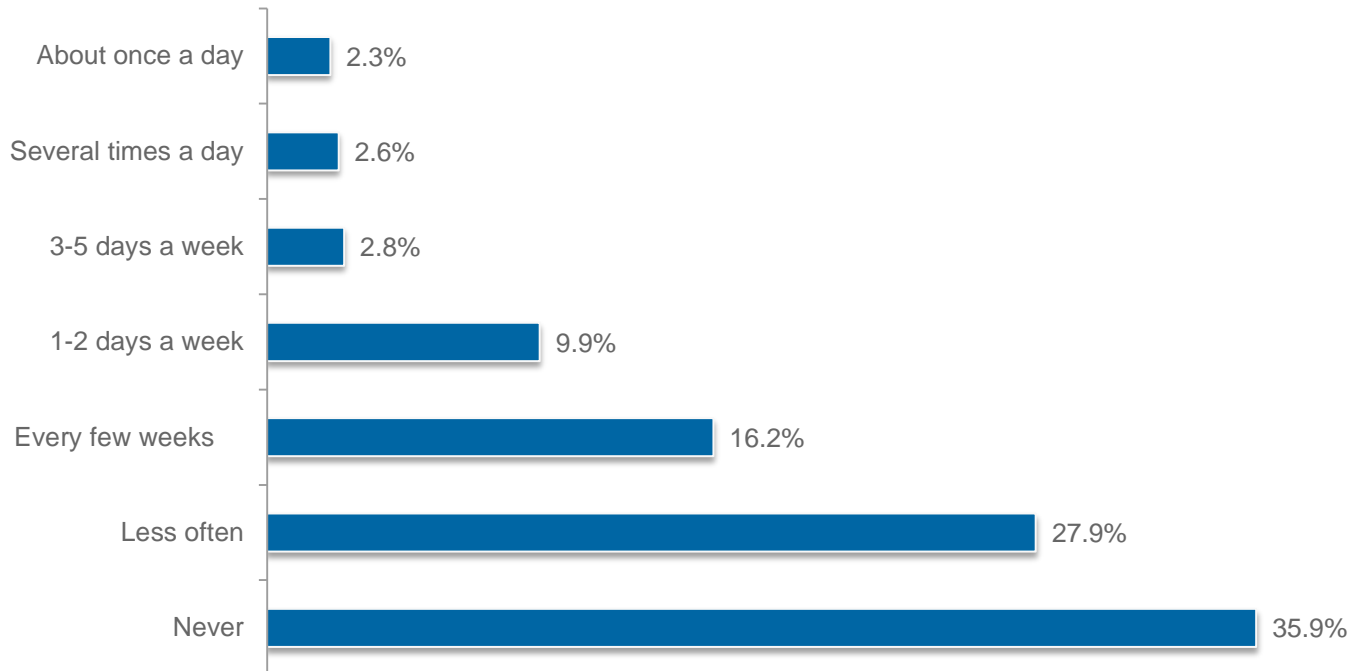

How often do you access the Internet or email using a cell phone?



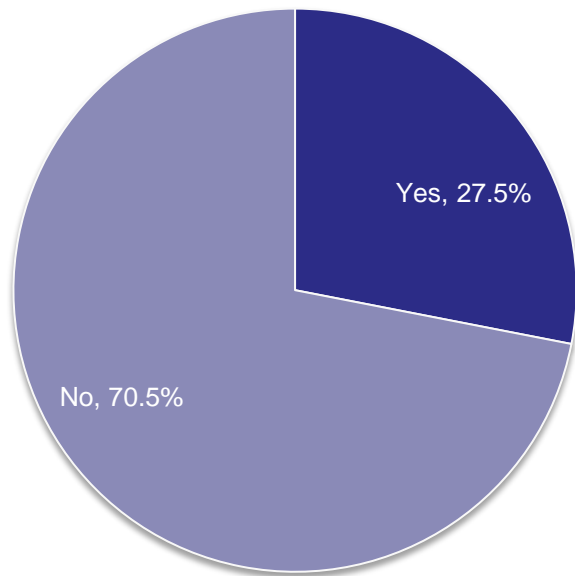
Results – Internet Access
