“What Research Says to the Classroom Teacher About Reading”

The Michigan Reading Association announces the publication of a new brochure for all classroom teachers and administrators. **“What Research Says to the Classroom Teacher About Reading”** is designed to present the latest research findings about reading in a concise and easy to understand format.

The research has been divided into the four following areas:

1. The Goals of Reading
2. The Reader
3. Learning Activities/Instructional Strategies
4. Materials

The brochure also offers a Glossary, Bibliography, Guidelines for Materials Selection and the new Philosophy of Reading for Michigan.

The brochure summarizes the research in 25 statements of research evidence and then discusses the classroom implications and the teacher knowledge necessary to implement the findings. The research will also give the reader a knowledge base for understanding the new philosophy of reading for Michigan and the resulting changes in the MEAP objectives and test.

The brochure was developed by the Curriculum Review Process Committee of the Michigan Department of Education which was composed of 22 professional educators representing classroom teachers, reading specialists and consultants, Chapter 1 and Bilingual teacher/directors and teacher education representatives.

The brochure is published and distributed by the Communications/MEAP Ad Hoc committee of the Michigan Reading Association.
