HOUSING

All apartments are furnished with beds, desks/chairs, dressers, closets, kitchen, table/chairs, couch, easy chairs, stove, and refrigerator. The apartments are air conditioned. Note that there are no microwaves or hair dryers in the apartments. Each guest room will be provided with fitted sheet, top sheet, pillow and pillowcase, blanket, bath towel, hand towel, washcloth, shampoo, soap, plastic cups, and toilet paper. Note that housekeeping services will not be provided during your stay, but you may check out irons, hangers, hair dryers, alarm clocks, and extra blankets/pillows/towels at the front desk.

Each hall has a common area with seating (including outdoor seating on the bottom floor), kitchenette with microwave, and a TV. Laundry rooms are located in each hall—you can stop by the front desk and obtain a free laundry card to operate the machines. There are vending machines on the first floor for snacks and soft drinks. The front desk also has DVD players, board games, basketballs, and volleyballs available for checkout.



Taxi



City Bus

Off-campus restaurants and other resources, including downtown Grand Rapids, are accessible by catching the Rapid Bus 50 at Kirkhof Center on campus, where it stops once an hour. Note that hourly service for Route 50 will be extended on Monday August 10 and Tuesday August 11 by one hour in the evening, so that the last eastbound bus departs Kirkhof at 9:00pm. The Rapid does not run on Sundays.

ON-CAMPUS ACTIVITIES

The Meadows Golf Course

Recreation Center



The facility houses over 60 cardio machines, a free weight area, selectorized weight machines, a 1/9 of a mile elevated running track overlooking the courts, and four multipurpose courts (basketball courts). Types of activities include basketball, volleyball, badminton, jogging, and walking. Locker and towel services, as well as equipment rental, are available. The Rec Center also houses the pool, which has some open lap/swim times.

Guests may purchase a daily user pass for the Rec Center for \$5, and for the pool for \$5. A pool day pass only permits access to the pool and locker rooms. Both Rec Center daily user passes and pool passes can be purchased at the Recreation Center Front Desk.



WEST MICHIGAN TRIVIA

Q: Why is everything 'Grand'?

The Grand River winds its way from Lansing through Grand Rapids and Grandville. It empties into Lake Michigan at Grand Haven.

Q: Why do all the street names have directions?

The city of Grand Rapids is divided into four quadrants by Fulton Street and Division Avenue, which intersect downtown at Monument Park. Most street names are notated with NW, NE, SE, or SW based

on their position relative to this intersection. This can be important when two streets on opposite sides of the city have the same name!

Q: How do I turn left?

A <u>Michigan left</u> is the typical type of intersection design in Michigan where one of the roads is a divided highway. It generally involves driving through the intersection, making a U-turn, and then turning right.

Q: Why does everyone talk funny?

The <u>Northern Cities Vowel Shift</u> is a dialect region of American English centered around the Great Lakes. 'Cot' sounds like 'cat' and 'cat' sounds like 'kiat'.

Q: Why does everyone have a funny name?

West Michigan was a destination for Dutch immigrants fleeing religious persecution and serves as a home base for the Dutch Reformed Church in North America. This is reflected in the names of Holland and Zeeland, MI; in the number of religious colleges in the area (Kuyper College, Cornerstone University, Calvin College, and Hope College); and in the Dutch surnames which grace the buildings and storefronts:

DeJong	de-YUNG	'the young'
DeVos	de-VAHSS	'the fox'
Dykstra	DIKE-stra	'from the dike'
Hoekstra	HEK-stra	'from the corner'

Q: Who is Mary Idema Pew?

The Mary Idema Pew Library and Information Commons is named after the daughter of Walter D. Idema (EYE-de-ma), a founder of Steelcase Inc. Her husband, Robert C. Pew II, was among GVSU's founders and an early board member.

Q: How do you get to the Upper Peninsula?

The <u>Mackinac Bridge</u> (pronounced 'mack-in-aw'), which connects St. Ignace on the Lower Peninsula with Mackinaw City on the Upper Peninsula (or U.P.), is the longest suspension bridge in the Western hemisphere. The Little Mac Bridge on GVSU's campus is named in its honor. By the way, folks who live on the U.P. are called 'Yoopers'. The rest of us are 'trolls'—we live 'under the bridge'.
